

2024-2026 MANDATORY CARRIAGE AND
CHANNEL POSITION ELECTION STATEMENT
FOR STATION WVXF

This Statement constitutes the election for the three-year period beginning January 1, 2024, pursuant to Section 76.64 and/or Section 76.66 of the Rules of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"), by Caribbean Broadcasting Network, LLC, licensee of Station WVXF, Charlotte Amalie, U.S. Virgin Islands (the "Station"), for mandatory carriage by the multichannel video programming distributors listed below whose system(s) serve those communities, counties, and any unincorporated areas within such communities and counties throughout the U.S. Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico within the Station's "television market" as set forth in Section 76.55(e) of the Rules of the FCC, including any modifications thereto pursuant to Section 76.59 of the Rules of the FCC.

In addition, pursuant to Section 76.57 of the FCC's Rules, the Station elects that such multichannel video programming distributors carry the Station on Channel 17 in all of the community(ies) and county(ies) and unincorporated areas within those community(ies) in the Station's "television market."

This election is effective for the period beginning January 1, 2024 and terminating as of December 31, 2026.

This will certify that this Statement will be placed in the Station's public file no later than October 1, 2023.
