They urge everyone on the water to wear a life jacket, even if you are the world's greatest swimmer. You never know what can happen. Kootenai Health works with the Sheriff's office to keep multiple life jacket loaner stations in our area stocked so there really is no excuse to not wear one.

Our region has a growing problem with elder abuse. The Washington State Department of Social and Health services reports over the last 5 years adult abuse investigations have nearly doubled. 25 percent of their investigations are into reports of financial exploitation that can take a variety of different shapes such as cosigners on bank accounts and taking money without permission or forging signatures on titles. In fact those are just a few things to watch out for if you are a family member or friend of an older person.

You've heard of marijuana, and maybe THC, but you may not know about CBD. The cannabis compound has no psycho-active properties, and is believed to have a lot of untapped potential in the medical world. In the cannabis industry, CBD, or cannabidiol, is widely regarded as an excellent alternative for pain medicine. There's plenty of information that the compound also has healing properties, but because it's a Schedule 1 drug, doctors are frustrated that they can't conduct proper research.

In early August we had an important health alert for our viewers in Grant County. Healy officials said they had a confirmed case of a rare form of meningitis. We were told it was an isolated case and so far no death or secondary cases have been reported. However, they were working to find anyone who may have come in contact with the infected person from July 18 to 28.

Reclaim Idaho brought the "Medicaid Express Bus" to the Lake City with the goal of informing voters. Critics said they couldn't do it, but the grassroots campaign called 'Reclaim Idaho' got 56,000 signatures to put Prop 2 on the November ballot. They say it would expand Medicaid to cover 62,000 people in Idaho who make too much to qualify for Medicaid by the current standards, but not enough to afford health insurance. Under Proposition two, Medicaid would be extended to everyone under 65 whose adjusted gross income is 133 percent of the federal poverty level. That equals about \$16,000 for a single person or \$33,000 for a family of four. The group claims the expansion would actually save tax payers.

Flu season showed up in late September, and it normally starts in October. But Spokane Regional Health reported the first flu hospitalization in Spokane County in late September. Health officials say last year's flu season was the worst on record, not just in Spokane County, but in the entire country as well. In the county alone, 41 people died from the flu and more than 600 were hospitalized. This year, the health department is stressing everyone should get the flu shot, not just to protect yourself, but those around you, including children too young to be vaccinated, the elderly and people with an auto-immune disease.

In early July, The Washington State Department of Transportation and Spokane Transit Authority both put transportation plans in the fast lane. Construction is beginning on a multi-million dollar warehouse on the west plains. "Project Rose" is rumored to have ties to Amazon and is expected to create nearly 3,000 jobs when it opens next year. Now the DOT and STA are looking ahead to make sure the roads are ready when the traffic increases in that area. The state's timeline for the Medical Lake interchange reconstruction is moving up and with that brings an expedited timeline to the second phase of STA's new west plains transit center.

The westbound on-ramp to I-90 from Hamilton Street is planned to be closed from early July until October. Crews will spend that time repairing and resurfacing the bridge decks over second and third avenues. Eastbound ramps will not be affected by the construction. The Department of Transportation says it will make for a smoother ride.

Another huge company is putting down roots in Spokane. Amazon has confirmed plans to build a fulfillment center on the West Plains. When work on the 80-acre site began months ago, there were rumors that it was Amazon's project. We now know it will bring at least 1,500 jobs to our region, and construction of the 2.5 million square foot facility is expected to be done by the end of next summer.

Prohibition Gastropub was one of the businesses that were outspoken against the project before it began, the husband and wife co-owners had concerns with the obvious interruptions that would occur and making sure they could provide for their family. Jill Leonetti and her husband saved up money before work began. When it did start, they changed their hours to better work with the construction schedule. They also teamed up with neighbor Bellwether Brewing to deliver food to their customers, but they say one project has really made all the difference, they call it the Bees Knees which allows customers to donate 5 dollars to a chosen charity each month when they dine and drink at Prohibition.

Plans for new homeless housing in downtown Spokane had businesses saying, not so fast. Employees and owners from 40 local businesses signed a petition to get Catholic Charities to stop work on two new buildings. Linda Biel with Urbanna Salon and Spa started the petition. She says she's had several run-ins with the homeless, from vandalism to harassment. She believes new apartments for the homeless should be built outside downtown. Catholic charities says all homeless services are in the Spokane core.

More work on Spokane's Riverfront Park is moving forward. In early September the City's Park Board approved plans for the design of the Park's North Bank. It's expected to cost around \$625,000, or ten percent of the overall construction budget. The work will involve the design and construction of the North Bank regional playground. Renovation of the maintenance and operations facility and a 180 space parking area. Construction is expected to take ten months and be complete by May 2020.

3.) Education

Towards the end of summer, salary negotiations between the district and the Teachers Union here in Spokane are ramped up. After a State Supreme Court ruling, the Washington Legislature designated 2 billion dollars for teachers' salaries. 30 million will go towards salaries in Spokane. The Spokane Education Association wants to make sure that's where the money is going.

The Spokane Education Association said the District was offering a 3.1 percent raise. Teachers said that wasn't enough. Starting this year, because of a Supreme Court decision, every district in Washington will receive more state funding to pay for basic education costs. Spokane Public Schools was planning to get about 28 million dollars. But the district says although state money is increasing this year, local taxpayer dollars are decreasing in the coming years. Meaning the District wouldn't be able to support the salary raises in the long term.

In late August districts like Pullman, Moses lake, East Valley and Mead have come to an agreement to raise teacher salaries, using money from the state which was ordered in a 2012 Supreme Court decision. Those raises are around 12 to 15 percent on average, but some districts in Western Washington have agreed to increases as high as 34 percent. In comparison, teachers in Spokane Public Schools were offered 3.1 percent raises.

The tentative deal was announced around 8:00 at night in late August but details of the agreement took a while to be released. The agreement came as a major relief to the Education Association's bargaining team, who has spent many hours during the summer at the table with the school district, trying to come to a compromise. It was also welcome news to the 3,400 educators the team was representing and the thousands of parents and students who would have been affected by a possible teacher strike.

Both sides were frustrated at the lack of progress during the negotiations and had agreed to bring in a third party mediator if an agreement was not reached. Officials with the district said their offer was fair. Teachers in Spokane recently settled on an average raise of 13-percent. Mead teachers are receiving 16-percent.

District officials said they may have to cut some positions to pay for those raises. Spokane Public Schools received more than 27 million dollars after a State Supreme Court decision mandated the state fully fund public education. Local levies are going down while state money goes up. The District says they won't be able to make up for that loss while paying teachers substantially more so school leaders may cut jobs by leaving them unfilled. That goes for administrative jobs as well, according to the District. Some worry teachers and students could suffer from the staffing cuts.

In early July, Spokane police were searching for a person, or people, that shot a man and left him to die outside a home in the Bemiss neighborhood. It happened on the 3000 block of Nelson street near Bemiss Elementary School around 2:30am in the morning. Officers found the man who was shot multiple times in a driveway. They tried to save his life but he died from his injuries.

A man accused of shooting at a Spokane sheriff's deputy pleaded guilty to multiple charges as part of a plea deal. The Spokane County Sheriff's office says Mark Perry pleaded guilty to drive by shooting, attempting to elude a police vehicle, and unlawful possession of a firearm.

In mid-July we learned the daughter of Lori Isenberg has been charged with the crime of injury to a child. Isenberg is on the run charged with embezzling half a million dollars from the housing agency where she worked. She reported to police that her husband Larry Isenberg fell off their boat and drowned, but court documents show he had a lethal dose of Benadryl in his system and did not drown.

In early August, Leslie Baker was accidentally released from the Spokane County jail. The community wanted to know how exactly that happened. A \$100,000 dollar warrant was out for Baker's arrest.

Police say it's hard to pinpoint one specific cause but they say stronger patrols throughout the city are keeping an eye on hot spots for property crime. Then they send patrols to these areas to keep an eye on things.

Spokane's newest C.O.P.S. shop officially opened its doors in mid-September. The location is in southwest Spokane near Third and Cedar. All are staffed by volunteers, and have one officer assigned to each.

In early August, there were many fires burning close to Spokane and across the region. We were seeing a lot of the smoke in the Inland Northwest. With excessive heat warnings for Spokane and Coeur d'Alene off and on during the summer and high or extreme fire danger across Eastern Washington, KXLY spoke with a doctor to find out what you should watch out for.

The unhealthy air quality was only making things worse, despite the heat the city of Spokane had to temporarily shut down the local pools because it was so bad. Many of them opened later in the evening.

In mid-August, Spokane had an air quality index as bad as 175. With parts of Central Washington experiencing numbers north of 200. Those numbers are considered "unhealthy" and "very unhealthy" respectively. Those that have respiratory issues like asthma and bronchitis were told to avoid being outside altogether. Those with healthy lungs were ok to be in the elements for a limited time, but should have avoid activities like running, riding bikes or physical sports of any kind.

But one of the biggest issues she says she hear about are rent increases. For many people on fixed incomes an increase in rent could mean they have to move.

Nineteen years later, we hear from Tommy Griffin, father of NBA superstar Blake Griffin, who coached Julius; and in interviews from death row, Julius tells his version of events while federal public defenders retrace the steps that led to what they claim is a miscarriage of justice.

The State calls their star witness, Christopher Jordan, who testifies he was there when Julius pulled the trigger. The clock is ticking for Julius, but two witnesses have come forward in his favor since the conviction, and he now holds out hope thanks to his current lawyers.

- While at a clothing store, a woman is distracted by her phone as her children act out of control. They run around and destroy merchandise while she shops. How will other shoppers react? (OAD: 6/19/15)
- A teacher is out with her student to supposedly help him study. They start to discuss their relationship and it quickly becomes apparent that there is something more going on between them than just tutoring. Will those who overhear comment on the situation? (OAD: 6/24/16)
- At a toy store, a young boy loves the dolls and selects one for his mother to buy him. But she is determined to have him pick out what she considers a boy's toy. A young girl wants to play with a truck, but her mother does not agree with her choice. What will other shoppers think when they see the mothers disapprove? (OAD: 7/28/17)
- A mom coaches her clearly musically gifted son as he plays the guitar, but nothing the child does is good enough. Will others step in? (OAD: 6/26/15)

Friday, July 13, 2018

- A pregnant teen tells her parents that she no longer wants to put her baby up for adoption and instead wants to raise the child. Her parents disapprove and push for adoption. What will those who overhear say? Joining to watch the action behind the scenes is Catelynn Baltierra, "Teen Mom" star.
- An African-American man, wearing a hooded sweater, is shopping at an upscale clothing store in Manhattan. Although the customer has done nothing wrong, the salesperson becomes uneasy and begins to insinuate that the customer can't afford the clothing being sold. Eventually the salesperson calls the security guard to pat him down before he leaves the store, simply because of his skin color and clothing. How will fellow shoppers react? Will anyone defend the man? (OAD: 5/23/14)

- A mother and daughter are at a clothing store and begin to treat the salesperson poorly. The daughter bosses the salesperson around and tells her that because her parents can afford the entire store, she should receive better treatment. Will fellow shoppers step in?
- A woman is grocery shopping and instead of pulling items from the shelves, she's taking from other shoppers' carts. What will others say?
- A man in a full tuxedo walks into a bar. He starts talking about how he is supposed to get married in a few hours, but he doesn't think he can go through with it. Will other customers support him and give him advice? What happens when the bride walks in?

Friday, July 20, 2018

- A child is at a sports memorabilia store trying to replace an autographed baseball belonging to his dad after he accidentally smudged the signature on the original. He discovers he's a few dollars short. Will fellow shoppers help the child replace the ball or advise him to come clean to his father? Joining to watch the action behind-the-scenes is actor Chauncey Leopardi. This scenario is inspired by "The Sandlot."
- A waiter is struggling to take a customer's order due to his stutter. The customer quickly grows impatient and starts to yell at the waiter. What will fellow diners say? Will anyone defend the waiter? This scenario is inspired by "The King's Speech."
- A mom and daughter are at a boutique clothing store when the mother tries to force her daughter to try on clothing that is too small. The mother explains that it will motivate her daughter to exercise and lose weight for the summer, but the daughter is clearly uncomfortable wearing a dress so tight. Will anyone step in? This scenario is inspired by "Spanglish."
- A mother and her two children walk into a sporting goods store. The mother wants to buy her son soccer cleats. The son says he doesn't want to play soccer, he wants to study ballet. His mother believes that sports are more appropriate for a boy. What will others in the store say to the mother and son? This scenario is inspired by "Billy Elliot."
- A transgender man and his girlfriend are out in public together when others begin to harass them about their relationship. What will bystanders do? This scenario is inspired by "Boys Don't Cry."

Friday, July 27, 2018

- A muscular female trainer is insulted for being too fit by someone watching her workout. What will others who overhear say?
- A man and woman are at a restaurant discussing with their teen child that they are separating after many years of marriage because the father has come out as gay. But their teenager is not happy to hear the news. Will fellow diners step in and say something?
- A diner asks other diners to watch his laptop while he takes a phone call outside a restaurant. They agree and after he steps away, someone tries to take the laptop. What will the diners do? (Rebroadcast. OAD: 7/7/17)
- A mother is out to lunch with her children who are loudly playing on their electronic devices, running around, making a mess with their food and clearly disrupting other diners' meals. The mother does not try to rein in their bad behavior and even steps away to make a few phone calls. Will anyone in the restaurant say something about the behavior?

Friday, August 3, 2018

- Two women are having lunch at a restaurant when one tells the other that she's pregnant. Instead of reacting with joy, the woman tells her friend that she is too old to have a child at 48, causing the pregnant woman to become noticeably upset. What will those who overhear do?
- A Hispanic couple is at a diner when their white waitress arrives to take their order. When they have a hard time speaking English, the waitress grows frustrated and begins to insult them. Will fellow diners step in and say something?
- A waiter at a restaurant is too busy telling jokes and stories to do his job. Will customers speak up or let him continue?
- A minor is in a store and asks other older customers to buy e-cigarettes for him. What will customers do? (OAD: 7/24/15)
- A fake baby is placed in a car with a speaker attached so passersby hear crying coming from the child. When the parents leave the child alone in the hot car to run an errand, how will people react? (OAD: 8/8/14)

Friday, August 10, 2018

- A man wearing a Make America Great Again hat walks into a café and takes a seat. Immediately the café's manager expresses that he does not agree with the politically themed hat. The manager tells him he must remove his hat before he can be served, but the customer defends his right to express himself. The scenario is then reversed when the same man walks into the café wearing an Impeach 45 shirt, and the same manager refuses to serve him, saying he finds the customer's shirt to be disrespectful.
