On behalf of Armada Media - McCook, Inc., licensee of the above-referenced station, you are respectfully requested to grant special temporary authority for station KBRL to operate at its licensed tower site at 25% of licensed power nondirectional while maintaining monitor points due to transmitter damage.

As the result of extensive rain, the building housing the KBRL transmitter flooded to the depth of about two feet of water damaging the transmitter which will not currently maintain licensed power. A temporary transmitter will be installed to permit the station to operate with a nondirectional antenna at 25% of licensed power day and night.

STA is in the public interest so that the station may continue to broadcast important information to its listening audience until the extent of the flood damage may be assessed, potential insurance issues may be addressed, necessary equipment may be ordered and delivered, repairs completed and station may resume operation at licensed parameters.
