<u>SYNOPSIS:</u> Topics discussed on today's program:

- Louisiana Legislature rejected proposal to repeal common core.
- Instead a committee was formed to seek a compromise between teachers and common core.
- The committee that was drafted for the standards evaluation had 96 pro-common core members handpicked by the department of education with only seven slots permitted for opponents.
- Students are given a test to determine if they pass or fail, teachers are given a test to determine if they are effective or not, and schools are given a test to determine their rank. If ranked lower than a "C" the state takes over the school and repurposes it as a charter or other educational program.
- Common core test scores were never released to the public.

• Common core curriculum wasn't released to the public so parents and teachers could prepare children for the tests.
