The program also provides information on upcoming events in Columbus and surrounding communities. The live 15 minute program provides great interaction between community leaders and the public. It is a great program for promoting positive programs and events in the area.

The two minute daily program is a discussion between local fitness experts at the Columbus YMCA. The program offers tips on healthy lifestyles and informs the public of education and interactive programs throughout the community.
