Section A -- Ascertainment of Community Needs

WTKE-FM makes a continuing effort to ascertain the needs of the communities it serves, and to address those needs in its programming. Information is gathered through the station's ongoing contact with community leaders, the news media, and the public at large. The station provides programming to meet those needs through a variety of radio programs and public service campaigns. Section B -- Public Affairs and News Programs

WTKE-FM airs "Florida Roundtable." This is a weekly one-hour interview and discussion program covering state and national issues affecting Florida. "Florida Roundtable" is produced by Florida's Radio Networks (FRN) and is co-hosted by FRN Public Affairs Director Reagan Smith and attorney, syndicated columnist and former Florida Congressman Lou Frey. The program's guests include state and national newsmakers and authorities.

"Florida Roundtable" is broadcast every Sunday morning from 8:00am- 9:00am (Central Time). Public Affairs Program Reports, which summarize the topics discussed in these programs, are attached to this report. Any variances from the regularly scheduled programs are noted.

WTKE-FM airs Fox National news twice an hour 24 hours a day.

WTKE-FM airs Local News twice an hour 6am-6pm

WTKE-FM also airs local news once an hour weekday mornings from 6 am thru 9 am. And again in the afternoon 4pm-6pm. In addition to reporting hard news, these newscasts also serve as an information source to the community on those issues of concern.

Additionally, WTKE-FM Local mid day programs to address social issues that not only affect the world of sports, but society at large. Example: The cause and effects of abuse and how to get help. With college football players as well as professional football players having their lives exposed has opened up many issues from sexual and battery abuse and effects it has on the family.

Section C -- Public Service Announcements

In order to serve the needs of the large number of deserving community groups, events, and non-profit organizations in its service area, WTKE-FM broadcasts public service announcements 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. One recorded PSA is aired per hour.

To further serve the needs of the community in a significant manner, and to respond to special needs and circumstances, WTKE-FM donates additional airtime to the community in the form of recorded PSA's on a frequent and continuing basis. These PSA's address a wide variety of issues that apply to large segments of the community, and are scheduled on a case-by-case basis.
