STANDOFF: The suspect in a standoff in Winstead Minnesota has died, police have confirmed, following an incident in which two deputies were shot. The update from the Mcleod county Sheriff's Office was issued around 6:30 pm following an hours-long standoff in the city about 20 miles west of the twin cities. The circumstances of the suspects death have not been revealed . The body was found inside the barricaded property using a drone. Aired 1-24-23 :30 in length.

DRUG ARREST: A woman suspected of selling Fentanyl on the red Lake Reservation has been arrested by Red Lake Police. According to a press release Katrina Oakgrove is charged with possession with intent to sell and unlawful possession of a controlled substance. She was arrested following a traffic stop on Jan14th. SNOWMOBILE CRASH: A Minnesota man is dead after a snowmobile crash near the town of Bowdon , ND in Wells County. GAS PRICES: For the first time this year the national average price for gasoline has had a weekly decline, primarily thanks to a sharp and sudden drop in the price of oil. Gas Buddy says it's not unusual to see prices falling in February, which tends to be the month with some of the lowest gas prices of the year.
