Round lake in Otter Tale county was the latest body of water in Minnesota to have Zebra mussels. The department of natural resources said they were found on equipment being removed for the season on Round lake's eastern shore. LAWSUIT:

KSTP channel 5 news out of the twin cities is reporting that Todd county agreed on Wednesday to pay \$1.8 million to the family of a mentally ill man who killed himself while in the county jail in June of 2017. A civil right lawsuit documented how jailers repeatedly ignored signs That Brett Huber Jr, was suicidal and guards went so far as to falsify jail logs to make it look that they checked on 25 year old Huber at the same time he hanged himself in his cell.
