7/10/23 8:30a-9a Carson Johnson, Leanne Petty, and Tom Britt talked with NC Secretary of The Treausry Dale Folewell about the Mountain Valley-Soutgate Pipeline extention proposed to be built through Alamance County. The pipeline will provide natural gas to Virginia and North Carolina. Discussed economic impact, lawsuits that have been filed, current court rulings, and potential environmental impact. Discussed the pros and cons of the pipeline as well and usage of Imminent Domain to build the pipeline. Discussed the legal and ethical implications of using Imminent Domain to claim property for private businesses. **EC, EH, POL, IN, GR**

Talked about Chamber Night at the ballpark, an opportunity to highlight the work of the Alamance County Chamber of Commerce, and recived an update on expansions and improvement to the stadium, which is owned by the City of Burlington. **EC, IN, GR, FY**

7/26/23 8:30a-9:00a Carson Johnson, Leanne Petty, and Tom Britt talked with Chief Harrison of the Haw River Police Department regrading their National Night Out plans. Talked about National Night Out and the need for cummunity policeing, the ability for police officers to be present in the community in non emergency situations. Discussed the challenges of the Haw River police department as one of the smallest departments in the county that faces a higher per capita crime rate than other communities. **LE, PA, CD**

7/27/23 8:30a-9:00a Carson Johnson, Leanne Petty, and Tom Britt talked with Sheriff Terry Johnson and his new Chief Deputy Jackie Fortner. Discussed the Sheriff's Office's National Night Out plans, which are in partnership with the town of Haw River, as well as introduced Jackie Fortner. Chief Deputy Jackie Fortner retired from the Alamance County Sheriff's Office two years prior and came out of retirement to accept the position. **LE, PA, CD**

7/31/23 8:30a-9:00a Carson Johnson, Leanne Petty,a nd Tom Britt talked with Emily Adkins, PIO for the Burlington Police Department regarding their National Night Out plans. Discussed NNO plans throughout the county. **LE, PA, CD**

8/10/23 8:30a-9:10a Carson Johnson, Leanne Petty, and Tom Britt talked with Kelly Hunter, PIO for the City Of Mebane and Chief Mitch Mickinney, the new chief of the Mebane Police Department. Discussed Chief McKinney's goals for the City of Mebane, his background in law enforcement, and the changing face of law enforcement. Talked about the challenges officers face today and the specific challenges he faces as the new chief in Mebane. Kelly Hunter discussed the ribbon cutting for Lumos Fiber, a new high speed internet company expanding to Mebane. Lumos will privide fiber optic high speed internet to areas of Alamance County that previously have not had access. .The new infrastructure provides access to nearly 70,000 homes that have been previously unconnected. Lumos is also leveraging its NC GREAT grant money for the expansion and is receiving grant money to help digitize the Mebane Historical Museum's collections. LE, GR, IN, PA, EC, ART

Kurt Ward interviewed head coaches Jeff Snuffer of Western Alamance, John Kirby of Eastern Alamance, Fritz Hessenthawler of Southern Alamance, David Grimm of Cummings, Patrick Stokes of Williams, and Tony Aguilar of Souther East Alamance. Discussed challenges of coaches in 2023 and post COVID, talked about rezoning and the impact of the new Southeast Almance high school. Talked about challenges of creating a program from scratch at Southeast. Talked about Alamance County's history of strong athletic programs. **HA, COVID, GR**

8/23/23 7:30a-8:00a Carson Johnson, Leanne Petty, and Tom Britt talked with Les Atkins, PIO for Alamance Burlington School System. Discussed mold problems in multiple Alamance County schools, rescheduling the first day of school, the impact it will have, how the school system is moving forward, mold remediation, costs associated with the mold, reasons the mold problems occurred, when the issues were identified, how the schools and county would pay for repair, and transparency from the school system with the community and tax payers. Discpelled some myths about the mold issues and discussed potential reasons the problems weren't found earlier and the possability more would be found. Discussed NC beuing named, for the second year in a row, the Number one state for business in the country. Discussed the reasons for this honor, including lower taxes, fiscal responsibility, low debt ratio, and being one of only 13 states with a AAA credit rating. **EC, POL, GR**

9/7/23 7:30a-8:00a Carson Johnson, Leanne Petty, and Tom Britt talked with Wayne Brewer about the upcoming Alcovets Ballon Festival. Wayne is a Vietnam Veteran and they discussed the needs and challenges faced by veterans economically, physically, and mentaly. Discussed the Balloon Festival and and its economic impact on Almanace County including out of county tourists coming to visit. **EC, MI,**

9/7/23 8:30a-9:10a Carson Johnson, Leanne Petty, and Kurt Ward talked with Kelly Hunty, PIO for the City of Mebane. Discussed plans for the City's new Elevated water tank with the ability to hold 3.3 Million gallons of water, the increased fireflows for the community, the community and economic growth that created the need for the tank, the search process for finding the proporty and needs for locating the new tank, the cost to tax payers, and bidding process. Talked about the new Greenway Project which will make the city more attractive to businesses and new residents, discussed the temporary closing of Lake Michael for the project, and the \$100,000 dollar grant for the project from Impact Alamance. Talked about expansion of LINK Transit to Mebane and the new greenway areas, the 2040 Comprehensive Transportation Plan adopted by Mebane in 2018, and the Comprehensive Land Developmant Plan. Discussed school bus saftey and th ABSS bus safty campaing. Of the 150 school buses on the road each day in alamance county, on average, 24 times per day someone passes a stopped school bus. Discussed Meals On Wheels history of taking care of the elderly who are on a fixed income by not only feeding them but also providing human interaction and providing wellness checks. Talked about Burlington's new "Social District" in downtown Burlington and the economic impact it will have on the city. **HN, EC**
