**Articles of Incorporation
of
Boise Community Radio Project, Inc.
A Non-Profit Corporation**

Pursuant to the provision of the Nonprofit Corporation Act of this state, the undersigned incorporators hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article I

The name of this corporation is Boise Community Radio Project, Inc.

Article II

This corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding future federal tax code.

This corporation is organized and shall be operated in accordance of plans to obtain and hold appropriate authorizations from the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), to construct, own, lease, or operate, and maintain one or more non-commercial, educational broadcast radio station(s) and related equipment, used primarily for transmitting musical, cultural, entertainment, local news and public affairs programming to the Treasure Valley area, as well as other underserved communities as determined necessary by the Board of Directors; and to offer instruction in the operation of such radio stations to members of the general public.

These programs are designed to serve the educational and public needs of the community, pursuant to the rules and regulations of the FCC governing non-commercial, educational broadcast stations. The corporation is further empowered to obtain and hold by contribution, deed or lease, real or personal property and funds to be used in connection with the operation of the broadcast station(s); and to solicit and accept, in trust or otherwise, money and property to be used for these same purposes.

This corporation shall engage in, advance, promote, and administer education and charitable activities and projects and to aid, assist and contribute to the support of institutions which are organized and operated exclusively for education and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as now or hereafter in effect. No substantial part of the activities, property or the income of the corporation shall be used for the purpose of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by Section 501 (h) of the Internal Revenue Code), and in no event shall the corporation participate in or intervene in (including publishing or distributing statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Article VII

The corporation does not have voting members.

Article VIII

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principle office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.


Article XIV

The corporation does not and will not afford pecuniary gain, incidentally or otherwise, to its members, and no part of the assets or net income of the corporation or any other pecuniary gain or profit shall ever inure to any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any of any private person, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes of the corporation set forth in these Articles. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article X

The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual.
