1. RAISING FUNDS FOR CHILDHOOD CANCER RESEARCH

Program Title: "Adam's Angel's Ministry's 6th Annual Angel Dash"

Description: KTTX helped promote the Angel Dash, which was held at Hohlt Park in Brenham on Saturday 10/4 from 8:15 a.m. until 12 noon. Participants ran Varying length races to raise money for childhood cancer research. KTTX aired advance promotional ads, live DJ liners and aired a live interview.
