

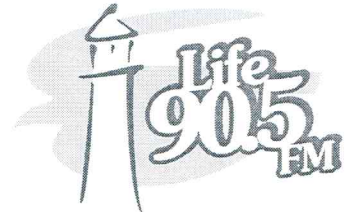

Attached is a listing of some of the significant issues responded to by WWIL-FM, Wilmington, NC. This is by no means an exhaustive list.

WWIL feels it is important to keep our listeners informed and we do so with a weekday local newscast as well as national news. We also carry other news-orientated features daily. Financial matters are a major concern for most working families and so every weekday we carry "My Money Life" a 2 minute daily program at 8:55 am & 4:40pm to help address and answer questions dealing with money. We also carry "Joni and Friends", a daily program that deals with issues of the disabled. Some of the issues addressed during the past quarter include; religious freedom, the Pope's visit to USA, First Amendment issues, how technology is affecting children, addiction and healing, difficulties in step families, the Iran Agreement, financial counseling, Republican's Presidential debates, the Kim Davis controversy, divorce & re-marriage and should Christians support gun control.
