Dear Affiliate Partner:

To assist you in complying with the reporting requirements for children's television and the requirement that stations air "core" children's programming, we are providing you with episode-specific descriptions (the 'NBC Kids" educational and informational programming block) as set forth in the attached Community Relations Quarterly Children's Programming Report for the 3rd quarter of 2015. The report includes information to help prepare FCC Form 398. Please note that we have not included the specific dates and times for each of the programs as that may be station-specific.

This report is divided into the following categories:

- 1. Educational Objectives: NBC Kids for both 3rd quarter 2015 and 4th quarter 2015.
- 2. <u>Core programming</u>: Regularly scheduled programming furnished by the NBC Network that is specifically designed to serve the early educational and informational needs of children 16 and under. Each of these programs is identified on-air as educational and informational with the "E/I" icon, and is similarly identified to the national listing services. To assist stations with the preemption report section of FCC Form 398, we have added specific episode numbers. Please note that the age target for NBC Kids programming is identified as 2-5 years old.
- 3. Other programming: Programming furnished by the NBC Network that contributes to the educational and informational needs of children 16 and under, but is not specifically designed to meet the educational and informational needs of children.
- 4. Public service announcements targeted to children 16 and under.
- 5. <u>Non-broadcast efforts</u> that enhance the educational and informational value of NBC Network programming to children.
- 6. <u>Network on-air promotional efforts</u>, which include a schedule of NBC on-air promos for NBC Kids programming.

The regularly-scheduled children's programming and promotional content furnished to you by the NBC Network during the 3rd quarter of 2015 complied with the commercial limits of the Children's Television Act, and 47 C.F.R. §§ 73.670(a)-(d), provided that you broadcast and distributed such programming as furnished to you by NBC, and did not add any promotional or advertising content thereto other than as directed by NBC via weekly postings on APT.

Under the FCC's video description rules that became effective on July 1, 2015, full-power affiliates of the ABC, CBS, Fox and NBC networks that are located in the top 60 television markets must provide 50 hours per calendar quarter of video-described programming during prime time or in children's programming. A video described program may be counted toward the 50 hours when it is originally aired and on one re-airing. Although much of the programming aired with video description is likely to be newly produced, stations may count any program they are airing for the first or second time with video description after the effective date, even if the programming toward its 50-hour obligation even if that programming has aired elsewhere with video description, as long as it is airing with description for the first or second time on that station.

3rd QUARTER 2015 EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

In compliance with the Children's Television Act regulations that became effective January 2, 1997, the **NBC kids** programming block features an on-air icon (E/I) indicating that each program is "educational and informational" for children. **This icon is displayed throughout each program.** Also, in compliance with the regulations, the following document, which includes "early educational and informational" objectives of **NBC kids**, must be placed in your public file.

The **NBC** kids programming block also meets the requirements for video-described content, as established by the Twenty-first Century Communications and Video Accessibility Act, effective October 8, 2010. Full-power affiliates of NBC that are located in the 25 television markets with the largest number of television households must provide video-described content at any time they are providing children's programming. Each episode of content can be aired no more than twice in the calendar year.

Each of the programs listed below, which make up the three-hour **NBC kids** programming block, is specifically designed to serve the early educational and informational needs of children ages 2-5. All of the programs have educational objectives and messages that are core to the content and appropriate for the program genre.

From July 4th – September 26, 2015 **NBC Kids** aired five shows returning from the 1st Quarter 2015. These are: **Astroblast, Lazy Town, Earth to Luna, Poppy Cat, and Tree Fu Tom.** There is one new show: **Ruff-Ruff, Tweet, and Dave**.

All six shows were developed specifically for a target audience composed of children ages 2-5. They have a narrative format and two of the shows (**Earth to Luna** and **Tree Fu Tom**) use elements of fantasy and imagination to develop the educational content. **Tree Fu Tom** combines live action with animation, while **Lazy Town** is live action with puppets. **Poppy Cat, Earth to Luna, Ruff-Ruff, Tweet, and Dave** and **Astroblast** are animated series.

Ruff-Ruff, Tweet, and Dave (RRTD) is an animated show which puts an emphasis on logical thinking and use of language through fun problem solving adventures. The trio, RRTD, is guided by Hatty, an erudite hamster who wears a hat full of questions. The three characters agree that they would like to take a particular adventure and rev up their Roly-pods, enter the Spin-Again transport vehicle and arrive at their destination. Once there, Hatty challenges them to make decisions and choose options that will lead to success or failure with their quest. Once their mission is complete, they review their effort, assemble the

Roly-Pods and head home. Their adventures are varied. They might go climb a mountain, design their own fairy tale, or build a sand castle.

Astroblast, based on the book series by author and illustrator Bob Kolar, is set on a space station in an unknown solar system. Five animal characters and one three-eyed octopus of unknown derivation populate the station. Each episode begins with an everyday conversation or incident that grows into a predicament needing a solution. While these predicaments take place in a fantasy environment, the issues and resolutions resonate for a preschool audience. Through comedy and zippy action, our target audience sees how the characters learn lessons for practical living such as how to keep track of things that belong to you, practice good habits, clean up when you've made a mess, rebound from a failure or an embarrassing incident, or resist the urge to blame others for your mistakes.

Lazy Town encourages fitness and healthful habits for preschool children. In the imaginary setting of Lazy Town, characters' eating and fitness habits are linked to problem solving in their world. The lead character is Stephanie, a young girl who guides the audience through the story as she and her friends ("human" puppets) and her Uncle (Mayor Milford Meanswell) navigate life within Lazy Town. Robbie Rotten, the underground spy and influencer who personifies the ethos of Lazy Town, is determined to ruin the health and fitness practices of Stephanie and her friends. When the kids have difficulty with Robbie Rotten, Sportacus (a gymnast/athlete prepared to answer any call for help) comes to the rescue from his home in a zeppelin-like aircraft that hovers over earth. The underlying themes of Lazy Town stress the importance of eating "sports candy" (aka fruits and vegetables), always obtaining sufficient sleep, and going outside to engage in a wide range of physical activities that include playing games, competing athletically, and even building forts and play structures.

Earth to Luna is a Brazilian animated series about 12 year old girl, Luna, who loves science and the outdoors. There is nothing she doesn't question, and she shares everything she learns with her little brother, Jupiter, her parents or her friend Alice, and Clyde, her pet ferret. In each episode Luna and her brother develop questions about whatever they find curious, e.g., "What goes on inside the snails' shell?" or "Why does a firefly blink?" In pursuit of answers, Luna, Jupiter and Clyde go off on an imaginary adventure to do their research. They transform into the object or creature they are studying so they can personally experience the answers to their questions. When the threesome is finished with the "field trip" Luna summarizes everything they have learned with a show and a song.

Poppy Cat based on a book series by Lara Jones, models the use of imagination and storytelling to encourage creative thinking in viewers. Each episode features the narrator Lara, reading a story about Poppy Cat, to her own cat (who is also named Poppy). She weaves an exciting tale following her imagination, which leads her to distant lands reached by boat, plane, hot air balloon or train. Each story features Poppy Cat as the leader of a group of animal friends, including the resident bully Egbert the badger, and other occasionally recurring characters. A prevailing message emerges within each episode to be nice to your friends and always work together. There remains an overarching implicit message within every episode as well; think creatively and exercise your mind through reading and storytelling – for these activities always lead to enjoyment and adventure.

<u>Tree Fu Tom</u> is a live action/animated series about a little boy who lives in a rural area, and has a rich fantasy life in the woods behind his home. Tom uses specific movements to summon up magic powers that permit him to morph into an animated hero and fly around in Treetopolis, the fantasy version of his woods. While in Treetopolis, Tom and his friends, Ariella, Twigs, Squirmturn and Zigzoo will invariably run into a problem or disaster that needs fixing. Tom calls upon the audience to practice original dance moves that

will bring him "Big World" magic so he and his friends can resolve their challenge of the day. Educational messages reinforce positive socio-emotional content, with examples that model: being loyal to good friends, knowing how to ask for help, doing the right thing instead of what is convenient, making the effort to share rather than being selfish and relying on teamwork in order to accomplish a goal.

4th QUARTER 2015 EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

There is one new show joining the schedule in the 4th Quarter, **The Clangers**.

The Clangers is a beloved British series that was originally conceived by Oliver Postgate in 1969 and has been reconceived and invigorated by his son, Daniel Postgate. The show features the Clanger family, small mouse-like creatures that live on Clanger Planet far away from Earth. The members of the family are presented with many unusual challenges that become the center of a dilemma that must be resolved within each episode. Strange visitors arrive out of nowhere and the Clangers have to figure out who and why they are on Clanger Planet. Sometimes they need to help or rescue someone who has become lost on the planet. Other times, they are trying to understand outer space; meteors and comets and eclipses of the sun or moon. Each member of the family has a forte', from playing music to knitting or gardening or inventing equipment that comes in handy for some of the problem solving that takes place.

3rd QUARTER 2015 SHOW SUMMARIES

Ruff-Ruff, Tweet, and Dave [RRTD] is a preschool adventure/activity show where the lead characters travel to faraway lands to have adventures with their guide, a hamster named Hatty. Ruff-Ruff, the dog, is the most playful of the three; Tweet is a little bird who loves to fly and get creative with her suggestions; and Dave the Panda has a thing for bananas. **RRTD** might go to the beach, or the mountains, or to strange lands with pillows everywhere; just the sort of place where imagination and logic come together. The settings are always brightly colored and beautiful. And their transport vehicles are Roly-pods, artful go-carts that fit on a spiral ramp that folds in and out of the Spin-Again, a colorful round spinning top with special compartments designed to anchor each vehicle right on the outside rim during the journey.

<u>Astroblast</u> is the space station and home of six animal characters in Bob Colar's book series of the same name. The space station is managed by an over-confident and exuberant commander, Comet the dog. The crew includes, Sputnik the pig, a very knowledgeable reader; Haley, a rabbit, an athlete and Comet's true peer; Radar, the monkey, who is somewhat self-involved; Jet, a silent alligator whose gestures and expressions are his mode of communication, and Sal, a congenial three-eyed octopus who runs the counter in the space station café, the Smoothie Shack. While the space station supports the missions of a bizarre and diverse array of aliens, the Smoothie Shack is the hub of social interaction for the galaxy. There is always something happening at Astroblast and everyone on the crew has plenty to learn to keep the community happy and on an even keel.

<u>Lazy Town</u> is a show featuring the importance of health, fitness, and being good friends. Set in a fantasy world known as Lazy Town, which is populated by inactive residents, we meet a visitor named Stephanie who is determined to coax her friends and relatives into adopting a healthful, active life style. She wins over her new friends, Ziggy, Stingy, Trixie and Pixel, convincing them to leave their gaming consoles and candy stashes at home so they can go outside and play. She persuades her uncle, Mayor Milford Meanswell, and his friend Ms. Busy Body to support her efforts. Robbie Rotten, who lives underground, and is determined to return Lazy Town to its former state of inactivity and quiet, constantly foils the characters' efforts. The athlete Sportacus lives in a zeppelin-like aircraft and receives signals from the kids

or the Mayor whenever they need help. He frequently comes to their rescue. Sportacus has two goals, to keep the peace and to promote healthful, positive living. When Robbie Rotten is discovered and contained through comic pratfalls, he returns to his underground lair and all is well in Lazy Town, until another day and another time when Robbie will rise again.

<u>Earth to Luna</u> is a series that stars big sister Luna and her little brother, Jupiter. Luna teaches her brother through play and adventure that typically takes place in their backyard. Science and experimentation are Luna's forte but fun and music are always on the on the menu of activities. Often the music provides compelling details about the scientific findings. Luna's friends, Alice and Tom, often join the kids. Clyde, her pet ferret is ever-present and provides lots of comedic action. And Luna's parents are there to praise the children's accomplishments which they reveal through a little vignette at the end of the story.

Poppy Cat is based on the Poppy Cat's Adventures book series authored and illustrated by Lara Jones. A narrator, also named Lara, reads a story to her cat in each episode. This story stars the narrator's own Poppy Cat, who envisions and takes his friends on imaginary adventures. The friends are Zuzu, a Dalmatian who zips around on a skateboard; Alma, a southern belle bunny who is ultra-feminine and sweetly dramatic; Mo, a little mouse who tries his best to do as much as everyone else despite his size; Owl, the wise one who is prone to neck rolls and commentary when things irritate him or don't make sense; and the grouchy Egbert, an arrogant and obnoxious badger who refuses to play with the group and invariably attempts to sabotage their adventures. Occasionally Hilda, a forgetful and ditzy pigeon who flies into their adventures, appears, says hello and provides misguided directions to the friends. Once their mission is accomplished, the friends return to their little village and resume their cheerful, active lives. At the conclusion of her story, Lara closes her book and says good-bye to Poppy Cat, who is usually ready for his nap.

<u>Tree Fu Tom</u> focuses on the amazing adventures of a young boy called Tom who, with the power of 'Big World' magic that depends upon specific movements, can transform into a tiny but mighty magical super hero who travels to the wondrous enchanted kingdom of Treetopolis. During each program Tom calls upon the audience to follow his moves and send him the "Big World" magic he needs to solve the problem he and his friends are facing. These friends include Ariella, a butterfly who is also a rancher and has rope lassoing skills; Twigs, an acorn sprite who folds himself into an acorn when he's frightened; Squirmturn, a pill bug who looks like a large and imposing coal miner but is often timid and fearful; and Zigzoo, a green tree frog who is the resident genius inventor. In each episode there are action adventure sequences that are key to resolving the challenge of the day.

4th QUARTER 2015 SHOW SUMMARIES

There is one new show for the 4th quarter 2015. **The Clangers**, a beloved British series originally launched in 1969 by its writer, narrator and animator, Oliver Postgate, returns to broadcast television under the stewardship of Postgate's, son, Daniel. All of the features of the original series have been retained but updated to 21st century colors and materials. The main characters are the Clanger family, a group of pink knitted mouse-like creatures who walk upright: Mother, Major (who is father), Small and Tiny (the children) and Granny. Clanger Planet is small enough to walk its circumference and also riddled with caves and tunnels that house the family and their friends: the Soup Dragon and her baby, the three Froglets, and a group of singing flowers. Contextual features and characters include a sideways lake, singing trees, a cloud that has emotions, flying "cows" and the Iron Chicken who lives in a nest of harvested metal parts from the detritus of outer space. The tone is existential—each day presents its own story—which is usually happily resolved by one of the children or another family member. The series is fittingly narrated by William Shatner (Captain Kirk from the Star Trek television series).

"CORE PROGRAMMING"

RUFF-RUFF, TWEET, AND DAVE

A FAIRYTALE ADVENTURE [ERTD101H]

Ruff-Ruff, Tweet, and Dave wake up and tell Hatty which kind of stories they each like best. When Hatty asks what kind of adventure they will have, Ruff-Ruff, Tweet, and Dave yell excitedly, suggesting that he ask the hat. The hat tells them that they are going on a fairytale adventure, and they all board the Spin-Again. In Fairytale Land, they decide to make up a fairytale collectively. They find 3 keys of differing shapes, one of which unlocks a basket full of dress-up clothes. Ruff-Ruff gets a shield, Tweet picks a wand, and Dave chooses a wizard hat. When a squirrel takes Tweet's wand, they resolve to use nuts to bribe the squirrel in order to get the wand back. They learn that all fairytales begin with "Once Upon a Time" and end with "And They All lived Happily Ever After."

[Educational Message: Problem solving always has steps, which include defining the problem, proposing a solution, and choosing the one that will work.]

A BOUNCY ADVENTURE [ERTD101H]

Ruff-Ruff, Tweet, and Dave wake up excited to know what kind of adventure they are going on that day. The hat reveals that they are going on a bouncy adventure. They board the Spin-Again and arrive in Bouncy Land. While there, they play games in which they find out who can jump the highest, find the bounciest thing, and that sand makes objects less bouncy. When Hatty's hat gets stuck in a tree, they choose the bounciest thing, which is a Bouncy House, to get it down.

[Educational Message: Bouncing is when a person or an object goes up and down. Some objects (like a ball) bounce better than others (like a rock).]

GROWING CRAZY [EATB101DH]

Comet eagerly volunteers to plant sit Zorky while Sputnik goes on an errand for a couple of days. Due to his excitement, he fails to write down the directions Sputnik gives him. Comet goes off to have fun, neglecting Zorky. When he returns he notices that Zorky is wilted. Zorky then gets sucked up by space tubes throughout the Space Station. While Comet is searching for Zorky, Sputnik calls to say she's returning sooner than expected. Comet finds Zorky, but because he looks sick, he over waters and over feeds him. Sputnik returns to find an anxious Comet, who confesses everything. When Sputnik opens the door, Zorky grows throughout the Space Station. Comet apologizes to Sputnik, and Sputnik lets the Astroblast crew know that if they don't feed or water him, Zorky will shrink back in a few months. Halley creates a new smoothie with the peaches from Zorky.

[Educational Message: It is important to follow directions when taking care of any living thing; otherwise, it might get sick or weak.]

BUILDING THE PERFECT PRESENT [EATB101DH]

Comet is making a present for Sputnik's birthday: a custom-made bookmark to replace the one she lost. However, when he compares the gift he *made* to the gifts his friends *bought*, he starts to doubt if his gift is good enough. Comet creates new presents based on what his friends used in theirs, but fails. He then combines all the features of his friends' gifts to create the perfect gift. When he shows Sputnik her gift: A Super-Rain-Sparkle-Glitter-Plant-Music-Balloon, Sputnik is hesitant, but tells Comet she likes it. While showing her present, the balloon pops and goes zooming through the air to the ground. Comet is upset, but Sputnik says she enjoyed her present and their friendship is the only present she needs. Comet is still upset, but remembers the bookmark he made and gives it to Sputnik, who loves it.

[Educational Message: The best gifts come from the heart; whether they are purchased or handmade is not important.]

THE LAZY CUP [ELZT312DH]

The kids are excited about the World Cup, and decide to have their own "Lazy Cup". They practice and are all ready to play until they realize they don't have another team to play against. Robbie Rotten jumps in with a team of monsters he fabricated in his lair. The stakes are if the Robbie Rotten team wins Sportacus has to leave town forever. The kids are frightened by the monsters, and chaos prevails until Sportacus steps in to play. However, Robbie fabricates a second team of characters based on soccer players. Sportacus competes against them all by himself, but Stephanie manages to get away from the monster mess, giving Sportacus some back-up and an apple to sustain his strength. They pull off the win. Sportacus can stay in Lazy Town forever.

[Educational Message: Exercise, be active, eat healthy, and be honest about your abilities to help your team win.]

BUTTERFLY FEET [EETL101DH]

Luna, her brother, and Clyde decide to follow a butterfly around. They observe the butterfly patting her feet and wonder what the purpose of this action is. After conducting an experiment, they make believe they are butterflies to learn more about the phenomenon. A few butterflies they encounter on their make believe adventure explain to them that they have receptors on their antenna and feet, so they can taste with their feet. They also share that they pollinate flowers with their feet to help them grow.

[Educational Message: Butterflies taste with their feet, as they have receptors there. Also, pollen from flowers sticks to their feet, which helps it spread.]

THE WAGGLE DANCE [EETL101DH]

When Luna, Jupiter, and Clyde cannot find the honey, they decide to ask a honeybee for some honey. Luna observes a honeybee eating her slice of cake. Then, she notices some different bees enjoying the cake as well and wonders whether the first bee told the others about the delicious slice of cake. Luna, Jupiter, and

Clyde make believe that they are honeybees, fly to the hive, and observe a bee telling his friends about the location of Luna's cake by dancing. Luna and her friends call this "The Waggle Dance."

[Educational Message: There are alternate methods of communication besides speaking. Similar to the way that you communicate with movement in ballet, honeybees interact by dancing.]

ROCKET CAT RADIO [EPCT119DH]

Mo comes to the group with a key that can lock and unlock anything. Zuzu arrives with a Radio that transmits signals from Rocket Cat. This latter item seems to eclipse Mo's key in value. However, when Rocket Cat sends a "Mayday" blast from Green Cheese Moon, the group hurriedly takes an adventure in a rocket ship. They run into Gilda and Egbert along the way, with Egbert claiming to head a rescue team on the planet. Egbert imprisons the friends with Rocket Cat in his impenetrable jail, but Mo's special key unlocks the jail and leads to their escape back to earth.

[Educational Message: If everyone works together cooperatively, you can achieve an important goal.]

CASE CLOSED [EPCT119DH]

Mo has a new detective kit that includes walkie-talkies, disguises and other investigative paraphernalia. Just as the friends are talking about how to use the kit, Owl appears lamenting that one of his special books is missing. The group finds two clues, a blue feather and a purple pine cone. Poppy is certain that one of the clues requires an adventure to the Purple Pine Forest. On the way, they run into Egbert who has just taken up tree-hugging and thanks them for providing what we need to make paper. A loud squawk comes from one tree and soon they find a bird foot-print and a blue feather. They look up and find Gilda, who works part-time in the library tree and tells Owl he forgot to return the book to the library so she did it for him.

[Educational Message: When you're trying to solve a problem look for clues, even if they don't seem related, that might lead you to an answer. Then work with your friends to get the problem solved by tracking where the clues came from.]

ONE FOR ALL [ETFT114DH]

Rickety coaches the friends for a squizzle tournament He teaches them that a great team needs leadership, listening, communication, and focus. They have the chance to practice these skills while searching for an enchanted squizzle that they believe will help them win the tournament. They have to work together and use movement magic to follow a series of clues that will lead them to the enchanted squizzle. They locate the squizzle but then realize it's not enchanted; moreover they are trapped in a cavern of falling stalagmites, and have to save each other. They learn that only through teamwork can they amass the great power to succeed with their escape.

[Educational Message: Teamwork gives you power; it isn't magic but is created with practice and good coaching.]

RUFF-RUFF, TWEET, AND DAVE

A HIDE AND SEEK ADVENTURE [ERTD102H]

Ruff-Ruff, Tweet and Dave wake up and discover they are going on a hide and seek adventure. They board the Spin-Again and, when they arrive in Hide and Seek Land, they play a game of hide and seek. Hatty tells them that they can use their 5 senses in order to help them find their friends during the game. They also use their 5 senses to help Hatty find his hat.

[Educational Message: If something goes missing, you can use your 5 senses (hearing, seeing, smelling, touching, and tasting) to help you find it.]

A SINGING ADVENTURE [ERTD102H]

Tweet wakes up singing a pretty song. The hat reveals that they are going on a singing adventure, which Tweet is excited about. They board the Spin-Again and arrive in Music Land where everything makes music. Tweet wants to find a band that she can sing with. They explore high sounds and low sounds and assemble a band composed of Dave playing the drums, Tweet playing a bell, and Ruff-Ruff playing some musical pads on the ground.

[Educational Message: When singing, you can sing high or low. Also, you can make a band with your friends to play music.]

LOST AND FOUND [EATB102DH]

Comet is trying to beat the high score in a pinball game while Halley continuously interrupts him to help look for things she's lost. Halley loses the keycard to let customers in the shop. Comet offers to use his keycard and scolds Haley. After returning to his game, Comet discovers he has lost *his* keycard! Comet searches for his keycard while trying to hide the loss from Halley, but she ends up helping him search for it. While searching, they encounter Sal, who tells Comet that Halley is actually helping him in finding lost things because he's disorganized. He mentions that Halley is good at her job because she doesn't get annoyed with people and understands that everybody loses stuff. Comet apologizes for scolding Halley. Instead of getting angry, be helpful because one day you will lose something and need help finding it too.]

TWICE THE TALENT [EATB102DH]

The Astroblast crew decides to hold a talent competition. Halley, Jet, Radar, and Sal all have talents to perform but Sputnik and Comet can't think of anything. They decide to perform together. After trying various talents (dancing, painting, etc.), they decide their styles are way too different to perform together. Comet is big, exciting, and messy, while Sputnik is neat, simple, and refined. Sal tells them that working together doesn't mean you have to do the exact same thing. Comet and Sputnik decide to combine their talents (Sputnik reads a story, Comet acts it out) and they win first prize

[Educational Message: We all have different talents so work together to best use each person's talents and overcome differences.]

When Stephanie arrives, she doesn't want to just play video games in the house, she wants to meet other children and play outside. However, Robbie Rotten tricks the children to distract them from active play. Stephanie is upset and speaks with her Uncle Milford, who wants to help and suggests she contact a super hero. Sportacus receives her letter and arrives in Lazy Town, where his crystal caper allows him to sense problems and he can save the children when they need it. Robbie Rotten sets a trap for Sportacus, but Ms. Busybody falls prey instead, and Sportacus, Stephanie, and Uncle Milford end up saving her. Stephanie asks Sportacus to stay in Lazy Town and he agrees.

[Educational Message: We need to develop good eating habits and have an active lifestyle.]

TWINKLE LITTLE STAR? [EETL102DH]

While looking at some stars in the night sky, Luna, Jupiter, and Clyde wonder why stars twinkle. Luna decides to ask Edison, a savvy solar-system mailman. He tells her to conduct an experiment with a spoon and a cup of water. She discovers that the spoon appears to be bent in the water due to refraction. Luna, Jupiter, and Clyde make believe they are stars in the sky, where they learn that stars are actually round. They also find out that twinkling is a result of starlight changing direction as it travels through the Earth's atmosphere.

[Educational Message: Stars don't twinkle. Their perceived twinkle is due to refraction, as their light changes direction as it hits the Earth's atmosphere.]

ON THE RINGS OF SATURN [EETL102DH]

Jupiter suggests that he, Luna, and Clyde should investigate the "funny looking planet that likes to hoop dance," which they later learn is Saturn. Luna wonders if it is possible to walk or skate on the rings of Saturn. After making a mini Saturn from Luna's ball and some hoops, Luna, Jupiter, and Clyde make believe that they are planets and discover that Saturn's rings are made of dust, rocks, and ice. Since the rings are not solid, Luna and her friends are not able to walk or skate on them.

[Educational Message: Even though they look solid, Saturn's rings are made of dust, rocks, and ice.]

Poppy and her friends discover a ring that fell from the planet Teenie-Tiny and they decide to return it. She gets stuck on an asteroid and everyone has to help to rescue her. She apologizes and realizes that she doesn't have to compete with Chester because her friends love her just the same. They return the ring to the planet and remain friends.

[Educational Message: When introducing a new friend to your group be sure to make them feel welcome, and don't forget that you are no less special to anyone because someone new comes along.]

WELCOME WALRUS [EPCT120DH]

Zuzu gives Owl a Welcome Walrus to hang in front of his house but he does not like it. Instead of telling his true feelings, he gives Zuzu excuses of other places to put it. When the walrus goes missing they find clues that lead them to the Mother Bumblebird and the walrus. On the way home they meet Roger the polar bear who is having problems making friends so they give him the walrus. Owl decides he wants another Walrus and asks Zuzu to make him another.

[Educational Message: When you receive a gift that you do not like, take time to appreciate the person who gave it to you and you might find you like the gift more than you originally thought.]

When it becomes more difficult than they expect, they have to earn each other's trust to guide one other through unexpected adventures.

[Educational Message: It is best to share with friends instead of being selfish; if you find yourself being self-centered you will have to make up your mind to work together and share.]

A MOUNTAIN ADVENTURE [ERTD103H]

They find the path to the mountain, but encounter a tree in their path; they resolve to go under it. Farther down the path, there is a muddy puddle in their way; they decide to go around it. Later, there is a river in their way and they decide to build a bridge to go over it. They finally make it to the mountain having learned how to get past objects in their way. Tweet is able to put her flag on the high mountain!

[Educational Message: You can avoid obstructive objects by going around, above, or under them.]

A BEACH ADVENTURE [ERTD103H]

After waking up, Ruff-Ruff, Tweet, and Dave learn that they are going on a beach adventure. They get on the Spin-Again and travel to the beach. Upon arriving, they all agree to build a sand castle. Tweet finds a bucket and shovel and they start building, but a wave washes it away. The wet sand, they discover, holds its shape better than the "crumbly" dry sand. Dave proposes that they build their castle out of wet sand on the dry sand, so it holds its shape but is beyond the reach of the destructive tide. They build a beautiful castle and decide to let a crab live there.

[Educational Message: When at the beach, you can build sand castles with your friends. Wet sand works better than dry sand for building.]

Sputnik assumes that since she is her friend, Glippi will like the same things she does. Sputnik and Comet fight over what she would like to do, but when Glippi comes, she doesn't enjoy either one. Glippi disappears and they find her playing with Halley, who is the only person who asked Glippi what *she* wanted to do. Sputnik and Comet apologize, and they all play together.

[Educational Message: To have fun, friends have to figure out what both friends will enjoy doing and not assume what one friend plans will be enjoyed by another.]

DR. ROTTENSTEIN [ELZT102DH]

Sportacus tells the kids he gets his strength from "sports candy" (i.e. vegetables). The kids are working in the vegetable garden, growing their own "sports candy," when Robbie Rotten decides he must stop this "vegetable junk" before everyone is running and jumping and being healthy. He disguises himself as Dr. Rottenstein and creates a new disease – spotty vegititis – to trick everyone into not eating vegetables, not getting fresh air, and staying inside and eating junk food – all while banning Sportacus from Lazy Town. Sportacus sends the kids notes, and Robbie Rotten breaks into Sportacus' aircraft to try and prevent Sportacus from sharing his healthy habits. Ziggy has to revive everyone with carrots in order to help save Sportacus and his aircraft/home. Ultimately Robbie Rotten is exposed as the conniving doctor and Ziggy develops a love for vegetables that gives him the strength and energy to help out and make a difference.

[Educational Message: Candy doesn't really give you energy, but vegetables give you energy that lasts.]

BANANA SEEDS? [EETL103DH]

When Luna, Jupiter, and Clyde realize that bananas don't appear to have seeds, they decide to investigate how bananas grow. Luna hypothesizes that, since bananas don't have seeds, that they must be the seeds. After unsuccessfully trying to plant a banana and its peel, Luna, Clyde, and Jupiter make believe that they are bananas and ask the banana tree how bananas grow without seeds. The banana plant informs Luna and

her friends that one banana plant grows another banana plant, as small stems grow from larger stems (rhizomes) that then grow into banana plants.

[Educational Message: Bananas do not grow from seeds; the plant multiplies through its roots' ability to grown new trees.]

THE TALE OF KALE [EETL103DH]

Luna and Jupiter's dad is cooking kale for lunch. They notice that the big bunch of kale they gave their dad drastically decreased in volume and they wonder why this happened. When the kale didn't shrink during their experiment, Luna, Jupiter, and Clyde make believe that they are ingredients in the kitchen to investigate. Some kale leaves share with Luna that they are filled with water and that they wilt in the steam. An onion describes that this wilting is due to the leaves loosing water while cooking.

[Educational Message: Kale leaves seem to magically disappear when cooked. However, they are really just wilting as the leaves lose water as they cook.]

MOUNT ZUZU [EPCT121DH]

When Zuzu discovers that mountains can be named after people, he is determined to find his very own and plant his very own flag on it. Zuzu spots a mountain in the distance without a flag, but Egbert has already started climbing to the top with his flag. However in his rush, Egbert accidentally deflates their hot air balloon with the end of his flag. As they quickly descend, Poppy and her friends work together to avoid obstacles and discover another mountain without a name. Zuzu decides to name this mountain "PoppyOwlMoAlmaZuzu" after all of his friends. Gilda and her friends give them a lift in their balloon back home.

[Educational Message: It is best to work together as a team when there are obstacles too big for you to conquer alone.]

PEARL HUNT [EPCT121DH]

Alma gets a new bracelet made of beautiful pearls. When Mo takes the bracelet and accidentally breaks it, one of the precious pearls fall in the lake. Poppy and friends take an adventure in the ship to Oyster Bay to go diving for a new pearl. After a long and fruitless search they are ready to give up. At long last Mo comes across an oyster that gives up one of its pearls to replace the one that was missing. Alma is very pleased and they head back to shore with the new pearl.

[Educational Message: Don't give up when a task seems insurmountable because a result can be achieved when you least expect it.]

THE GREAT JOURNEY [ETFT116DH]

Ariella needs some help on the ranch, so she teaches Tom and Twigs that to be a rancher you have to maintain control, gain trust, and work together as a team to manage responsibilities. Twigs and Tom watch the beetle eggs for her and when they hatch early Twigs and Tom have to take action to gather the

hatchlings, get them to their food and to their parents. Together they are able to overcome many obstacles along the way.

[Educational Message: If you remember the advice your friends give you and work together you will be able to take responsibility when you need to.]

RUFF-RUFF, TWEET, AND DAVE A PIRATE ADVENTURE [ERTD104H]

Ruff-Ruff, Tweet, and Dave make up a pirate name for themselves and each put on a pirate hat. Hatty shows them a treasure map that they use to guide them to the treasure. When they reach the red "X" on the map, they discover a treasure chest on a pirate ship. They open it and it has bones for Ruff-Ruff, bananas for Dave, and shiny shells for Tweet. They all love the treasure they found!

[Educational Message: Maps can help you navigate through an unfamiliar place.]

A FARMYARD ADVENTURE [ERTD104H]

Ruff-Ruff, Tweet, and Dave wake up and Hatty's hat tells them that they are going to go on a farmyard adventure. They board the Spin-Again and get to the farm. Hatty finds a note from Farmer Fred that outlines the jobs that need to be done that day: take the cows to the milking barn, gather eggs from the hens, and pick some strawberries. They successfully finish all these tasks and make a delicious farmyard meal: milkshakes, strawberries, and scrambled eggs.

[Educational Message: At a farm, you can pick strawberries, milk cows, and collect eggs from hens. You can also make a healthy and delicious meal from the food produced at the farm.]

SMOOTHIE OPERATOR [EATB104DH]

Comet goes to throw away the smoothie but Sputnik stops him and urges him not to waste. Comet decides it's not wasting if you do it discreetly. After trying several ways to get rid of the smoothie, Comet succumbs to his hunger and tries Plorpian Plum and loves it!

[Educational Message: Always try new foods before throwing them out because you may discover that you like a new taste.]

BEND IT LIKE RADAR [EATB104DH]

The Astroblast crew is going to play their friends from Outer Veruvia in Quasmo Digi-Soccer. Radar doesn't want to participate and gives several excuses that don't work, until he tells them he's sick. When Halley checks on Radar and finds him jumping and playing video games, Radar tells everyone that he's not really sick and just didn't want to play. Comet understands and cancels the game because they don't have enough players. Radar confesses to Comet that he played Digi-Soccer before and accidentally scored a point for the other team. Comet convinces him to give it another try, and he scores a goal for *his* team.

[Educational Message: You should always tell the truth when you're afraid to try something you once failed. Lying may get you into bigger trouble, and you might have success with a second try.]

SPORTS DAY [ELZT103DH]

Stephanie realizes it is Sports Day, but the rest of the friends do not plan to participate. He decides to compete with them for the field, and if he wins, Sportacus will be banned from Lazy Town forever. Sportacus helps the kids train while Robbie Rotten devises tools to trick the kids during the competition. Sportacus puts Ziggy in charge of providing the necessary energy from "sports candy." Sportacus tells the kids that he has experienced sugar meltdowns because sugar doesn't give you lasting energy. Robby Rotten uses his candy-faker-maker machine to create a sugar apple to trick Ziggy and Sportacus. Sportacus has a major lead during the race, but when Ziggy gives him the fake apple he subsequently has a sugar crash. Robbie Rotten is certain he will win, but the kids figure out his plot and provide Sportacus with real "sports candy." They go on to win the race.

[Educational Message: Sports candy and energy building foods are fruits and vegetables. Sugar will not give you real/lasting energy.]

HOW WATER BECOMES RAIN [EETL104DH]

When Luna and Jupiter's mom warns them not to drink all the water because then there would be no rain, they wonder how water turns into rain. After observing that some of the water is gone, Luna, Jupiter, and Clyde make believe that they are drops of water to see what happened to the water in the cup. They discover that the sun turns water into water vapor, then into a cloud, and then into rain. After that, the cycle starts all over again.

[Educational Message: The heat from the sun turns water into vapor. The vapor turns into clouds, and then into rain.]

THAT JUST RAINED SMELL [EETL104DH]

Luna exclaims that she loves how it smells after it rains; this leads her to question where this smell comes from. Luna hypothesizes that the smell has something to do with worms and creates and experiment to test whether or not the smell comes from the worm. After this experiment, Clyde communicates that the smell comes from the wet dirt. Luna, Jupiter, and Clyde make believe that they are radishes to find out more. A worm explains to them that the just-rained smell is a result of the microbes that release a smell into the dirt and when it rains this smell is released into the air.

[Educational Message: The "just rained" smell results from microbes in the dirt that releases a smell. The rain releases this scent into the air.]

WISE TOAD [EPCT122DH]

Mo, Alma and Poppy are having a roly-poly race. When they realize Mo can't stop by himself, Zuzu swoops in to rescue him on his skateboard. When Zuzu shows the group some tricks on the skateboard he accidentally breaks it. They decide to take the train to see the skateboard wizard and get it fixed. When Mo falls again Zuzu manages to use the broken skateboard to save him. When the wizard sees his superb talent he decides to magically fix his skateboard so it will never break again.

[Educational Message: Just because a toy looks broken doesn't mean it can't be useful in a different way.]

RARE BIRD [EPCT122DH]

Mo has made a special tree for his art project that hangs pictures of all the birds he has ever seen. Unfortunately, Mo is missing the "Red Tipped Babblebird" and cannot finish his project without it. Mo enlists Poppy and friends to help find the missing bird to complete his tree. Everyone goes on a great adventure to find the bird and snap a picture. Mo has one photo left on his camera to use on the Babblebird but gets lost taking Egbert's directions. When they finally find the bird to take a picture, they discover that the bird is actually Gilda in a wig!

[Educational Message: Don't give up when you cannot find a solution because perseverance always pays off.]

NOT SO FAST [ETFT117DH]

Zigzoo invents a zippiositer for Ariella so that her plants will grow incredibly fast. But Ariella's impatience gets in the way and her plants grow out of control. Ariella breaks the machine and then apologizes for her impatience, and realizes that much bigger problems are caused by impatience. Meanwhile the Mushas decide to take advantage of the situation to use the machine for mischief by sliming the kingdom and growing huge weeds. Ariella is slow to learn her lesson about impatience and won't wait with the rest of the group to make a plan to stop the Mushas. Luckily they rest of the group works together to save both the Mushas from the zippiositer and help Ariella who has gotten caught in the giant weeds.

[Educational Message: Being impatient can lead to big problems. Develop your patience and be quick to apologize and correct your behavior when you make a mistake.]

The gang decides to have a race too. They follow the first rule of racing by lining up at the start line. After observing that Ruff-Ruff was running, Tweet was jumping, and Dave was running backwards, Hatty tells them that they need to make sure they are participating in the same race, which is the second rule of racing. During the race, a sheep passes Ruff-Ruff and he decides he is losing so he might as well stop. They restart the race and Ruff-Ruff ends up winning! They all had fun.

[Educational Message: While participating in a race, it is important to remember to line up at the start line and establish the type of race it is. Also, it is important to finish the race even if you don't win.]

A COLLECTING ADVENTURE [ERTD105H]

Ruff-Ruff is counting his collection of bones and Hatty explains to Tweet that a collection is a group of similar things. The hat tells them that they are going on a collecting adventure and they board the Spin-Again and head to the beach. Ruff-Ruff collects sticks, Dave collects round things, and Tweet collects seashells. Ruff-Ruff comes across a round pile of sticks, but just before Ruff-Ruff takes them, Hatty explains that these are for a bird's nest and that he should look elsewhere for sticks. They have fun collecting objects, and head back home.

[Educational Message: A collection is a group of things that all go together because they are the same type of thing. Birds collect sticks to build their nests.]

SPIC N SPAN [EATB105DH]

After the Astroblast crew hosts the Cinnamon Swirly Grubmeal show for the Glorpians, they are left with a big mess. They are about to start cleaning when the computer reminds them that the Crab Nebula Shooting Star show will start soon. They agree to clean up together really fast so they won't miss it. Using a chore ball they divide the cleaning, and Sputnik gets the easiest job. The crew gets frustrated and decides to finish cleaning when the show is over. Comet forgets his binoculars, and Sputnik goes to retrieve them but gets stuck to the floor and asks for help. The whole crew comes rushing in and they all get stuck. After working together to get unstuck, they decide to work together to clean the cafe from top to bottom and finish in time for the shooting star show.

[Educational Message: Always work together to clean up right after making a mess; waiting makes the work even harder to do.]

OH, BROTHER [EATB105DH]

Comet's brother Flash visits the space station and suggests that the crew should do everything faster, because faster is always better. Halley and Radar start doing things faster, but Sputnik and Jet disagree. Comet, not wanting to upset his older brother, agrees even though he is uncertain. When he sees how things are working better faster, Comet starts wondering if he's been running the Space Station wrong the whole time. Sal tells him he likes the way Comet runs the Space Station because he doesn't tell people what to do, he listens to them, and together they figure out how to do things. Comet decides to ask the crew whether they want him or Flash to run the Space Station. Comet walks into chaos at the cafe and the whole crew starts asking for his help. Comet decides to slow everything down, and Flash admits that maybe faster isn't better.

[Educational Message: Faster isn't always better, so take your time and do it right.]

Ziggy wants to be a hero that he's named "Sportacandy" – but he just keeps messing up his friends' projects instead. Sportacus reminds him to start small, and take one step at a time toward his goal. When Ziggy is still frustrated, Sportacus trains Ziggy to be a superhero. He tells him the secret is to practice and persevere. Meanwhile, the other kids are building a clubhouse, but Robbie Rotten wants to foil the building. Ziggy has completed training and tries to help again, but doesn't follow the "start small" advice and continues to make mistakes. While Robbie Rotten is sawing through the branch, he gets stuck. Sportacus saves him, and then Ziggy prevents Robbie Rotten from getting smashed by the branch. He realizes anyone can be a hero if you start small and take it step-by-step.

[Educational Message: Your friends like you for who you are, not because you have "super" powers. So if you want to excel at something, start small and continue practicing to become really good.]

MARTIANS, MARTIANS, MARTIANS [EETL105DH]

When Jupiter asks questions about Mars, Luna explains to him how the solar system works. Luna and Jupiter wonder if there really are Martians on Mars. Luna resolves that they should use her telescope to look for Martians on the red planet. When they don't see any, they make believe that they are rockets and go to Mars. They run into a mars rover named Curiosity who informs them that there is no known life on Mars and teaches them that Mars is a freezing desert with no air. He also explains that Mars is red, but sometimes looks green.

[Educational Message: Mars has two moons and all its water is frozen, due to its extremely low temperature. No life on Mars has been found.]

SHOOTING STARS [EETL105DH]

After Luna sees a shooting star, she asks Clyde and Jupiter to help her find it in their backyard. While they are looking, they wonder why stars fall and where they land. They spread pots, pans, and buckets all around the yard to catch the falling stars. When this doesn't work, they pretend that they are shooting stars in the sky and, unexpectedly, they turn into rocks. Some other shooting stars explain that they begin as rocky asteroids that turn into meteoroids and then into meteors (shooting stars). Luna, Clyde, and Jupiter also discover that as the shooting stars fall, they break up into pieces of rock so small it looks like dust.

[Educational Message: The phenomena we call shooting stars are not stars, but meteors. As they fall through the sky, they often disintegrate into dust.]

BALL GAMES [EPCT123DH]

[Educational Message: Always make an effort to find a way to include all your friends when playing a game. That way, no one is left out and feeling bad that they cannot play with the group.]

BIG BUBBLES [EPCT123DH]

Everyone is blowing bubbles in the garden, but Zuzu is upset that he can't do it like everyone else. Poppy receives a letter from her friend on Tiger Island that needs some cheering up so they travel to visit him. On the trip, Zuzu is still upset and takes his frustration out on Mo, making him feel bad about his bubbles. When their boat gets stuck, Mo uses his bubble blowing skills to make a bubble large enough for everyone to travel to the island. Zuzu apologizes for being mean to Mo and everyone spends the entire day with Poppy's friend Ravi blowing bubbles.

[Educational Message: We all have different talents, if you can't do something you shouldn't be mean to your friend because they can.]

A GARDENING ADVENTURE [ERTD106H]

Ruff-Ruff, Tweet and Dave discover they need to plant the seeds in soil in order for them to grow, since it has food for the plants. Ruff-Ruff decides to plant his in the shade, Tweet plants hers in the sun, and Dave plants his under a rock. Hatty teaches them that Tweet's idea is best, since plants need sunlight to grow. Then, they water their plants and learn that it takes time for them to grow.

[Educational Message: Seeds need soil, sunlight, water, and time to grow into plants. Also, you can use tools to plant the seeds.]

A FLYING ADVENTURE [ERTD106H]

Ruff-Ruff, Tweet, and Dave emerge from their sleeping pods and discover that they are going on a flying adventure. When they arrive in Flying Land, where everything can fly, they find a paper airplane that they throw to see how far it goes. Tweet wishes she could fly as far as a Bluebird and the group decides she should take flying lessons from this bird. When she can't stay in the air that long, they resolve to give Tweet a few balloons to help her stay in the air. She is able to fly with the balloons, but can't get down. She unties the balloons one by one and discovers she can still fly without them!

Educational Message: It's always good to get help from others when you are trying to learn something new. You can start with a teacher who is an expert and then get help from your friends so you can improve.]

The crew decides that since his cape is delicate, they won't play with Captain Super Duper unless Comet is around. Radar plays with Captain Super Duper without asking and breaks him. While hiding from Comet, Radar runs into Sal, who notices Captain Super Duper is broken. He tries to fix him but can't and Radar decides that he is going to live in the ceiling for the rest of his life. Sal uses Radar's favorite pencil to write his "goodbye" note to the crew, and he breaks the pencil. Sal has the courage to tell Radar what happened and Radar realizes that he should have the courage to tell Comet what happened to the action figure. Radar apologizes to Comet, and although Comet is mad, he is glad that Radar told the truth. Comet fixes Captain Super Duper and the crew plays with him.

[Educational Message: Always ask before touching someone else's things and always tell if you've broken something that belongs to someone else. It's very hard to do, but if it was an accident people will eventually understand.]

ROTTENBEARD [ELZT106DH]

The kids are playing pirates and when Uncle Milford drops by. He tells them a story about a pirate, Rottenbeard, who came to Lazy Town, wreaked havoc, and spread his meanness everywhere. He took everything he wanted, except the Lazy Town stone which was inscribed with the secret to living in Lazy Town. Rottenbeard broke the stone when he couldn't steal it outright and now it is missing the key-word that reveals the most important secret of Lazy Town. Robbie Rotten, who doesn't like the kids playing and being noisily active, decides to make a fake Lazy Town stone and lead the kids on a wild goose chase to find a fake stone that would tell them to "be lazy." But Stephanie is not convinced they should be lazy and leans on the real stone, only to uncover a compartment with a new treasure map. Once they retrieve the real stone, with substantial help from Sportacus, they find out that the secret to living in Lazy Town is to be HAPPY.

[Educational Message: Being lazy is very boring and unhealthy, but being active, like playing and dancing with your friends, will make you very happy.]

AS THE BREAD RISES [EETL106DH]

Luna and Jupiter are at their friend Newton's bakery, where they learn that bread roll dough turns into bread. The two wonder how exactly the sticky dough transforms into fluffy bread. Newton gives them instructions on an experiment that will help them understand how dough becomes bread. Luna, Clyde, and Jupiter make believe that they are bread rolls to learn more about the baking process. Another bread roll teaches them that rest is essential to the dough growing process. During this rest time the yeast eats the sugar in the dough, which produces gas the bubbles that make the bread fluffy.

[Educational Message: Yeast causes bread to rise. Yeast eats the sugar in bread dough, causing it to produce gas bubbles, which makes the bread grow.]

THE SINKING GRAPE [EETL106DH]

Luna and her family are at the lake, where Luna and Jupiter observe that their orange floated and their grape sank. Luna wonders how something so big floated, and how something so little sank. Luna fills up a small pool to test which of a variety of fruits sink and which float. They make believe that they are fruit in the pool. The apple informs them that neither size nor weight determines whether something sinks or not; density controls what floats and what sinks.

[Educational Message: Density, not weight or size, determines whether something will sink or float in water.]

CLOUD SONG [EPCT124DH]

Alma is entertaining her friends when she is interrupted mid-song by Egbert. Alma forgets what she was singing and when her friends try to help her, it confuses her even more. Poppy suggests they go on an adventure to find the tune in the Castle of Songs. Egbert arrives before they do and he takes them down a stairway so scary, he abandons them. Fortunately Gilda is in the basement of the castle with a music machine. She also gives them directions to the Room of Songs which is filled with music boxes containing songs. Alma founds her Song of Clouds there and finishes her "recital."

[Educational Message: When you work with your friends to solve a problem, you are very likely to ac hieve your goal and have fun in the process.]

TREASURE HUNT [ETFT119DH]

Everyone is excited for the annual treasure hunt. Treetog surprises everyone and pairs them up in teams of two for the hunt – with partners who share very different personalities. [Educational Message: When attempting to achieve a goal it is most important to work cooperatively with your teammates. If you do that you can reach a common goal, even when you are working with someone who is very different than you.]

RUFF-RUFF, TWEET, AND DAVE

A DANCING ADVENTURE [ERTD107H]

When Ruff-Ruff and Tweet wake up, they have fun dancing, while Dave thinks that blue pandas don't dance. The hat reveals that they are going on a dancing adventure. They all board the Spin-Again, arrive in Dancing Land, where Hatty teaches them about tempo, which he defines as the speed of a piece of music. They choose a tempo that is right for Tweet's dance. Then Ruff-Ruff tries to teach Dave his dance. To help Dave, Hatty counts the rhythm of Ruff-Ruff's dance, which he defines as the beat of the music. Dave comes up with his own dance, and discovers that blue pandas *can* dance!

[Educational Message: Tempo is the speed of a piece of music, and rhythm describes the beat of the music. Also, everyone has their own style of dancing.]

A KITE ADVENTURE [ERTD107H]

Ruff-Ruff, Tweet, and Dave are playing with "flappy flying things," which Hatty tells them are kites. His hat reveals that they are going on a kite adventure. They all pack their kites and board the Spin-Again. When they get to Windy Land, they fly their kites and discover that kites need wind to blow in order to fly. To find the wind, they look at the windmills to see where it is blowing. They are able to get their kites flying again, but they break when they all crash. They make a new kite out of sticks, cloth, and string from the old broken kites. When the wind blows, the new, big, super kite flies!

[Educational Message: Kites need wind in order to fly; objects like windmills can help you locate where the wind is blowing. Also, if your kite breaks, you can use the materials from the old kite to make a new one.]

Halley needs help delivering a large order of smoothies and asks for Sputnik's help. Sputnik reluctantly helps and after the delivery, Halley becomes Sputnik's hero. Sputnik starts dressing and acting just like Halley. Sal tells Sputnik that the only person she needs to be is herself. Halley gets annoyed with Sputnik and lies to get away from her. Sputnik finds out and decides to not be like Halley anymore. Comet, Jet, and Radar remind Sputnik of all her awesome qualities and that she doesn't need to be like anyone else. Sputnik and Halley apologize to each other.

[Educational Message: Trying to act like another person just makes you a copycat, so it's best to develop yourself based on your own talents and personality. People want to know you not a copycat.]

CRY DINOSAUR [ELZT107DH]

Stephanie, Ziggy and Stingy are going camping, but Ziggy is afraid of the dark. He asks Sportacus if he is afraid of anything, listing many possibilities, and Sportacus admits he would be afraid of a large dinosaur. Robbie Rotten is thrilled to hear Sportacus' weakness and disguises himself as a dinosaur to scare Sportacus out of Lazytown forever! When the kids settle down into their tent, Stephanie and Stingy calm Ziggy's fears with a song, but they immediately are terrified by the shadow of Uncle Milford on the tent. They decide to hold a camp-in at Stephanie's house. Ziggy hears a commotion, sees the Robbie Rotten dinosaur and is frightened. Stephanie and Stingy go out to explore but leave the door ajar and Robbie Rotten gets inside the house, scaring Ziggy some more before all the kids see him and run and hide. When the dinosaur goes after Stephanie and Stingy, Ziggy realizes he has to save them; he finds courage and tackles Robbie Rotten, causing the costume to fly onto Stingy. Sportacus comes to save them and congratulates Ziggy on being brave to save his friends.

[Educational Message: When you are afraid, and you still take action to protect your friends, you are demonstrating true courage.]

[Educational Message: A rainbow is composed of raindrops. Light from the sun passes through them, creating a rainbow.]

WHEN YELLOW MET BLUE [EETL107DH]

While Luna is painting, her yellow sun in her blue sky turned green; she wonders how this happened. She tries to recreate the painting and discovers that when yellow and blue mix, it turns green. To further test this, she unsuccessfully attempts to turn a blue toy duck green with yellow paint. Luna, Jupiter, and Clyde make believe that they are in the painting and ask the sun why Luna's blue sky and yellow sun came out green. The sun informs them that since the yellow and blue paint was wet, they mixed to make green. The primary colors further demonstrate how they make new colors when their pigments mix.

[Educational Message: Yellow, red, and blue are primary colors. When these pigments mix, they make a new color.]

Crying, Alma is ready to give up but when her tears water the soil the umbrella plants actually do start to open. Alma picks the one she likes. Her friends hum the tune and she gets to finish her dance after all.

[Educational Message: Perseverance and creativity can usually turn a bad situation into one with a h appy ending.]

BIRTHDAY TREASURE [EPCT125DH]

On Poppy's birthday everyone surprises her with a cake and gifts. But when Poppy comes across a mysterious gift of a treasure map, her friends suggest that they should take off on an adventure to find the treasure. While following the map, Poppy realizes that the real treasure is a surprise party orchestrated by all her friends. They all celebrate Poppy's birthday and have great fun.

[Educational Message: When everyone works as a team and puts their ideas together great things (like a surprise party) can happen.]

He decides to use magic to help with the clean-up, but when the magic doesn't work they realize the sap in the tree has been polluted from the rotten berry. Tom admits he threw the berry in, and he uses magic to reverse his mistake and make the sap good again before everything the bad sap touches in Treetopolis turns to stone.

[Educational Message: Pollution causes great harm to the environment.]

They surprise Hatty with a present that pleases him very much.

[Educational Message: Games are a great way to have fun at a friend's birthday party. Also, you can surprise your friend with a thoughtful present at their party.]

Radar and Halley are playing with action figure Billy Starrider and when Halley has to leave Radar goes to Sal to continue his game. He is so obsessed with the action figures Sal decides to leave and warns Radar that he needs to try something new. Radar then goes to a pick up game of Anti Anti-Gravity Freeze Tag but quickly inserts Billy Starrider into the game. Finally, in frustration, the team goes to work at the Frosty Star. Radar still wants to play Billy Starrider. He is driving customers away. Radar's friends confront him about always playing and talking about his action figures. Radar agrees and asks for help figuring out what else he could play that doesn't involve Billy Starrider. Halley takes him out on her surfboard, and he discovers that yes, there are other games to be played.

[Educational Message: Fixating on just one thing all the time means you aren't having as much fun with friends as you could have. You might lose friends because you won't try new things.]

[Educational Message: Your actions affect everyone, listen to your conscience and avoid selfish actions – instead choose to help out others.]

[Educational Message: The Earth's continuous rotation causes the sun to shine on different parts of the Earth. On the dark side, it's nighttime and daytime on the light side.]

LUNA'S LUNAR QUEST [EETL108DH]

Jupiter wonders why the moon looks different in each of its phases, so Luna launches an investigation. They observe how a miniature moon changes as light shines on it from different directions, but Luna still wants to know how the sun shines at night. They make believe that they are astronauts in space, where the moon teaches them that, as it orbits around the earth, the sun illuminates different portions of the moon.

[Educational Message: The moon's phases result from its orbit around the Earth. As it travels, the sun shines on it differently.]

She is very appreciative and Mouse thanks everyone for believing he could do something big after all.

[Educational Message: Even someone who is very small can do something very big.]

ACORN TIME [EPCT201DH]

The group is playing outside, but Owl is grumpy. He wants to go on a vacation. He wants another house. He wants to be left alone to sulk. The group starts talking about how to help Owl, when Mouse and Clara decide that Owl might feel better by planting an acorn tree that would grow really big. Poppy Cat suggests going to a forest where trees can grow very fast and then Owl will have his own tree to make him happy.

They go on their adventure, have a mishap, thanks to Egbert, but eventually get to the special forest where Owl's acorn is planted and his new tree really does grow very tall and wide. Treehouse Trevor agrees to take care of Owl's tree and he tells the group they can all use the big tree as a vacation home.

[Educational Message: It always good to do things that will cheer up a grumpy friend. When people see how much you care about them, their mood will change to show their gratitude.]

However, they have to find their way out, but Dave collected all the yellow arrows that led them there. They have to solve a matching game and a jigsaw puzzle to get out of the maze, which they do successfully.

Radar invents a Zippity Squeeze-a-licious-tron, which enables one person to run the cafe alone. He tells them to put only one fruit or veggie in at a time, so it doesn't get jammed. Comet is excited because it's 2-for-1 day at the Pingo Pongian Waterpark Superslide, and Halley decides to stay behind at the store since she's already been to the Waterpark. After the crew leaves, a large group of Kahoodians comes in and overwhelms Halley. She realizes that it will take forever to make smoothies for the large group if she only does one fruit at a time, so she puts a bunch in and overloads the Zippity causing a big mess in the kitchen. Halley goes looking for Sal but he is not available, so she decides to take it one step at a time. Halley fixes and cleans the Zippity, and successfully fills all the orders of the Kahoodians.

[Educational Message: When you are overwhelmed, try to calm yourself down and take things one step at a time. It might be possible to still get your work done without any help and things will be okay.]

But the trick is on him, because those who rest sufficiently have energy to overcome and succeed against his ploys.

[Educational Message: An important component of being healthy and having energy comes from getting a good night's sleep.]

While with a friend at Newton's bakery, Jupiter drops his ice cream on the ground. This leads Luna to question why things fall down and not up. They observe a ball falling and notice that something caused it to change direction. To investigate further, Luna, Jupiter, and Clyde make believe that they are astronauts on the moon. Everything is floating and the moon explains that this is because there is low gravity on the moon. The earth and the moon teach them that gravity is like a magnet at a planet's center that pulls everything to its center.

[Educational Message: Gravity is an invisible force that pulls everything down, like a magnet. The amount of gravity differs on each planet.]

WINGS OF A BIRD [EETL109DH]

Luna, Jupiter, and Clyde are searching for Jupiter's lost paper airplane when they encounter a birds' nest. Luna watches a baby bird learning to fly and wonders how birds learn to fly. Luna, Jupiter, and Clyde make different paper airplanes to study which one flies further. They make believe that they are birds in the nest and discover that birds have hollow bones that make them light enough to fly and strong muscles that allow them to flap without getting tired. They also learn that tail feathers enable the birds to steer.

[Educational Message: Birds can fly because they are light, due to their hollow bones, and have strong muscles. Also, their tail feathers help them steer.]

Along the way, the friends learn that there is a special skill to picking the olives – wiggling the lowest branch up and down. They find the tree, Mo wiggles the lowest branch, and olives pop out. "Professor Green Fingers" uses one of his enchanted plants to tickle Mo, Poppy and Owl so that they drop their olives. [Educational Message: Good friends don't let each other down just because they've had an argument. It is more fun to work together than to argue and hold a grudge.]

TIGER BIKE [EPCT202DH]

Poppy and her friends are watching Zuzu perform tricks on his new bicycle. Alma is worried about a letter from Ravi the Tiger on Tiger Island, because he left his bicycle on the beach, where it washed away with the tide. The group decides to help Ravi find his bicycle though Zuzu reluctantly agrees to go because he'd rather continue practicing his tricks. When the friends arrive at Tiger Island and meet up with Ravi, they dive underwater to look for his bicycle, but Zuzu abandons the search. The friends find an octopus named Ozzie pedaling Ravi's bicycle and though they plead with him to return it, he refuses. Ozzie negotiates a deal to give it up if he loses a bicycle race. Fortunately, Zuzu returns and accepts the challenge. He wins the race and is glad he stopped sulking and decided to join his friends by helping to retrieve the lost bike.

[Educational Message: If a friend has a serious problem, you can make the time to help; it always feels better to help a friend than to say "no" because you'd rather play].

Hatty is talking to Ruff-Ruff, Tweet, and Dave about opposite words and his hat tells them that they are going on an opposite adventure. When they reach Opposite Land, they play a game in which they find the opposite of what Hatty says. This game teaches Ruff-Ruff, Tweet, and Dave more about opposites and allows them to have fun while doing it. The gang also makes a new hat for Hatty out of the material from their opposite game. He loves it!

[Educational Message: "Opposite" means that two things are as different as different can be.]

When they each get their own Tribly Z-Max 3's, they stop playing together and neglect their work. Sal tells them that there is a time to work and a time to play, but they don't pay attention. When the power goes out, the friends and customers are bored. Comet thinks back to what they did before their Tribly Z-Max 3's and the Astroblast crew and customers create their own fun

[Educational Message: It is more fun doing things together than playing by yourself all the time.]

Sportacus and the gang later join together to save Robbie Rotten.

[Educational Message: Scouting is a healthy and fun activity; and friends still need to be there for each other even in the midst of disagreements.]

Their pet snail also teaches them that its shell protects it from harsh weather and harmful creatures.

[Educational Message: Snail antennae allow them to explore the world around them. Their shells provide protection from danger.]

ICE GIANTS [EETL110DH]

Luna, Jupiter, and Clyde are playing with paper boats. When Clyde's boat sinks, they all wonder what sinks boats in the oceans and want to find out more about icebergs. They make a miniature iceberg in a cup and observe its behavior while floating in a clear bucket. Then, they pretend that they are icebergs and learn that icebergs are made from fresh water. Some other icebergs also teach them that they used to be snowflakes, then glaciers, and now icebergs. The icebergs also explain that they move very slowly and that they provide homes for animals like polar bears and penguins.

[Educational Message: Icebergs start as snow, become glaciers, and then become icebergs. They move slowly through the water and provide homes for various animals.]

can make another one, and they decide to take all the yarn they've collected back home. As they plan their departure, they discover that a passing elephant has given their hot air balloon to his son for a birthday present. Poppy Cat apologizes that they need the balloon back in order to go home, but Zuzu steps up and gives the baby elephant a special gift of the remaining sleeve of his sweater. It's now a trunk warmer and the little elephant is overjoyed by this gift and Zuzu's generosity.

[Educational Message: The only things better than getting presents is giving presents, especially when your gift makes someone very happy.]

PILLOW VALLEY [EPCT203DH]

Mo is grumpy because his sleep was ruined by someone's snoring. Owl discovers a small hedgehog, Hilary, who is the noisy culprit. She is having a lot of trouble hibernating because she doesn't have a soft pillow. Poppy Cat suggests they go to Pillow Valley to help her. Along the way Egbert causes a diversion by pretending to be Lord Snoozley. One of his tricks causes Hilary to roll away. The friends run to help her and discover that Hilary rolled right into Pillow Valley, where one of her hedgehog friends is already hibernating. The friends give Mo a chance to take a nap before they leave, and once he's rested with a perfect pillow the friends head home.

[Educational Message: Friends needs to understand that everyone needs to get a good night's sleep in order to feel good during the day. If you or your friend is having trouble sleeping, maybe finding the right pillow will help solve the problem.]

They have to learn Rickety's lesson the hard way before the more careful friends can help save them.

[Educational Message: If you are careful and observant you will be safe and prepared for any situation – even helping your friends get out of a bad one.]

[Educational Message: Vegetables come from plants, which grow from seeds with the help of water and sunlight. You should eat vegetables because they make you strong.]

A HAPPY ADVENTURE [ERTD111H]

Everyone is in a good, happy mood except Tweet because she lost her tweet toy. The hat reveals that they are going on a happy adventure to Happy Land. When they get there, Hatty explains that a person's facial expression can tell you a lot about the way that person is feeling. Tweet has a sad face, and when Ruff-Ruff loses his ball, he has an angry face. When Dave hears an unfamiliar noise, his friends can tell he is scared based on his face. Ruff-Ruff is able to get his ball back, Dave discovers that it was just a frog making that noise, and Tweet gets her toy back. They are all happy and smiling!

[Educational Message: Our faces can tell us a lot about the emotions that we are experiencing. Also, it feels good to help make a friend happy.]

Halley also learns that her ankle is better, but loves the attention, so she doesn't tell her friends. After a week, her friends are tired, and since Halley is still hurt, they decide to all stay home and not go to the Pingo Pongian Waterpark Superslide. Halley overhears and shows her friends that she is better, but her friends don't believe her. Halley shows them that she is better, apologizes, and they all go to the Pingo Pongian Waterpark Superslide as a group.

[Educational Message: Taking advantage of others because they want to help you is really bad and, if you are not honest, they may not be there for you when you really need them.]

SPUTNIK TAKES A CHARGE [EATB111DH]

Sputnik wants to make changes to The Frosty Star to make it more organized and efficient. The Astroblast crew tells her that the craziness works for them as long as the customers are happy. The crew reluctantly lets Sputnik make changes, but after reorganizing, the cafe becomes chaotic. The crew is upset, but doesn't want to hurt Sputnik's feelings. When Sputnik asks Sal what he thinks of her changes, he asks her how the others feel. Sputnik asks the others, who tell her that they liked things the way they were. The crew then decides to go back to the old way of running The Frosty Star.

[Educational Message: You should always consider how others feel because your ideas are not the only ones that have merit.]

Luna, Jupiter, and Clyde make believe that they are items on the bathroom sink and learn that the steam cloud from the shower travels through the air and, when it reaches the cold mirror, it turns back into water. This process is called condensation. They also discover that the soap on the mirror prevents condensation because it doesn't allow the water molecules to stick to it.

[Educational Message: When the steam from a hot shower hits the cool surface of a mirror, the mirror gets foggy. This is called condensation.]

DO FISH DRINK WATER? [EETL111DH]

Luna and her family are at the beach. When Jupiter questions whether or not fish drink water, Luna decides to catch a fish in a clear bucket so they can observe it. They can't really tell whether or not the fish drinks water, so they decide to make believe that they are fish. They encounter some fish that tell them fish drink the salt water to stay hydrated and that they expel the excess salt out of their gills.

[Educational Message: To stay hydrated, fishes in the sea drink salt water and expel the extra salt through their gills.]

[Educational Message: It's always good to ask for advice, because with a little help, you can do learn what you need to do to improve upon what you are doing.]

CHOPPY HEDGES [EPCT204DH]

Alma shows the friends her potted topiary plant. Owl tells his friends he's always wanted to try topiary and tells them about a garden called "Choppy Hedges" owned by Carol. Alma tells Owl that Carol is looking for a new Chief Topiarist. On their way to Choppy Hedges, Owl is worried he won't be able to fulfill his creative vision. Everyone gives him great positive feedback but Owl refuses the job when he realizes that he would have to live away from his friends. Poppy suggests that Owl teach Carol how to cut topiary and once they start, she has ideas of her own.

[Educational Message: Making art is a process that depends upon your own vision of what you want

to create. Everyone has their own ideas and will express them in their own way.]

[Educational Message: There are seven colors in the rainbow: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo, and violet. Also, you can only see rainbows when there is rain and sun at the same time.]

AN EXPLORING ADVENTURE [ERTD112H]

Ruff-Ruff, Tweet, and Dave are drawing when Hatty's hat tells them that they are going to go on an exploring adventure. They have a whole island to explore! Ruff-Ruff, Tweet, and Dave want to find a Doggie-Birdie-Panda. At Hatty' request, they narrow down a few characteristics of the Doggie-Birdie-Panda that will help them identify it. They find a number of animals, none of which are the Doggie-Birdie-Panda. They discover that, based on the clues, they are the Doggie-Birdie-Panda. They were following themselves!

[Educational Message: When exploring and looking for something specific, you can follow clues (by identifying its characteristics) in order to find it.]

[Educational Message: It feels just as good to give presents as it does to receive them.]

During rehearsals, Comet is disruptive to Halley and the rest of the cast even though Sal tells him how important it is that they respect and support each other. During their last rehearsal, Haley becomes frustrated that she's not good enough and suggests she and Comet switch parts. Comet steps in for Halley, but before the play he sees Halley's family in the audience and decides that they should reverse their roles. Halley tells Comet that he deserves the lead because during rehearsals she didn't do well, and Comet admits that it's because he was always butting in on purpose. He apologizes for not being supportive and respectful.

[Educational Message: If you resent the task you've been given to perform you may end up making things hard for everyone else in the group.]

[Educational Message: Use your heart and follow your instincts to know what is right, and then stand up for that.]

Luna and Jupiter take Clyde to the vet to get his nails trimmed. Luna wonders if Clyde sees the world the same way that she does. During an experiment with colored balls, Luna observes that Clyde could only correctly identify the red ball. To learn more, Luna and Jupiter make believe that they are ferrets. They

discover that ferrets can only see red and varying shades of grey. Clyde explains to them that ferrets' heightened sense of smell makes up for their lack of vision.

[Educational Message: Animals see differently. Ferrets can only see limited colors and can't see very far. They make up for this with their excellent sense of smell.]

However, after an encounter with Egbert aka Captain Big Boot, the Most Mysterious Sailor on the Seven Seas-- the friends' boat is set off course and run aground a small sandbar. Owl apologizes for them getting stranded because of his flower but Poppy tells him they started on this adventure together and friends will stick together and make if fun. Then they realize they are sitting on the back of blue whale named Charles who offers to guide their boat to Sunnyside Island. When they arrive, they find more sunflowers and before they return home in their boat, Owl decides to leave his flower on the island where it can grow and be happy.

[Educational Message: True friends will help you solve the problems that are important to you and will stick by you even if the job is not easy.]

[Educational Message: If you've been told not to do tamper with someone else's equipment, don't let your peers influence you to use the equipment without permission. Your inexperience may result in a mistake that breaks or damages the equipment.
