ISSUES & PROGRAMS

Community Connection is a 5 minute week-day feature at 9:45, which also airs a complete weekly recap of all weekday shows Sunday mornings at 7 a.m. with host Jody Tosti.

10/10/2023 It's Columbus Day in the US. Or, most recently it's also known as Indigenous People's Day. To help us unpack these changes and the recent New York state bill to designate October 12th as Indigenous People's Day, Phillip White-Cree Coordinator of Indigenous Community Support and Outreach at Clarkson University and he joins Jody Tosti on "Community Connection."

10/11/2023 Today is National Coming Out Day which started 33 years ago on the anniversary of the National March on Washington for Lesbian and Gay Rights.
