Free tax prep, earned income tax credit services for qualifying families

Volunteer Income Tax Assistance sites open January 19 throughout Acadiana

Families and individuals with household income less than \$54,000 in 2015 may be eligible for free tax preparation services and a quick refund offered at 11 United Way of Acadiana-sponsored Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) sites throughout Acadiana January 19 – April 18.

IRS-certified, trained volunteers are also on hand to help families who qualify to receive the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC), which could mean up to \$6,200 back in their pockets.

To qualify for the EITC, Tax Year Earned Income and Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) must meet certain criteria. For example, a married couple with two children with a household income \$49,974 or less can qualify.
