1	COVID-19 – lying to a state trooper	Local News 7:00 am & Noon	4/1/20	2 minutes	The Alaska State Troopers are warning people against falsely claiming they have COVID-19. This is a crime resulting in a charge of first or second degree terroristic threatening. If you do have the virus, let the troopers know so they can take precautionary measures to protect themselves.
2	Bears	Local News 6:00 pm & 10:00 PM	4/1/20	2 minutes	Reminding people that bears are coming out of hibernation. Clean up trash from yards, removing anything with a smell bears may be interested in. Be aware of surroundings, keep on eye out for tracks, and make noise.
3	COVID-19 – wearing face masks	Local News 7:00 am & Noon	4/6/20	3 minutes	State health officials are now recommending people to wear a cloth face covering in public settings where social distancing measures are difficult to maintain, like grocery stores and pharmacies. People can spread COVID-19 and have no symptoms. Information was given on the proper use and washing.
4	COVID-19 – trips to grocery stores and pharmacies	Local News 7:00 am & Noon	4/7/20	5 minutes	National and local health officials recommend people limit trips to the grocery store and pharmacies. Stores like Fred Meyer and Costco are placing limits on the number of people allowed in the stores. Some stores are also starting a one-way aisle to control traffic flow.
5	COVID-19 – religious services	Local News 6:00 pm & 10:00 PM	4/7/20	5 minutes	Alaska Department of Health and Social Services issued guidance for those hoping to hold upcoming religious ceremonies while maintaining the current health mandates.

<b>6</b>	Burn Permits	Local News 7:00 am & Noon	4/8/20	5 minutes	Alaska Division of Forestry announced all burn permits have been suspended. Due to COVID-19 there will be a shortage of fire fighters, and an increase of risk to the firefighters who are able to fight fires.
<b>7</b>	COVID-19 – Grading guideline for schools	Local News 6:00 pm & 10:00 PM	4/9/20	5 minutes	The Fairbanks North Star Borough School District has released its grading guidelines for the rest of the 2019-2020 school year. Teachers for all grade levels are being advised to provide feedback, but not grades. Families are encouraged to stay engaged with learning.
<b>8</b>	COVID-19 – State Website	Local News 6:00 pm & 10:00 PM	4/14/20	2 minutes	The state has put together a website for coronavirus resources. Also contains case count updates, health information, news and announcements from the state. Website address was given.
<b>9</b>	COVID-19 – reopening Alaska	Local News 7:00 am & Noon	4/22/20	5 minutes	A new phase to start Friday. Guidelines were given for: restaurants, non-essential businesses, weddings, funerals and other small gatherings.
<b>10</b>	2020 Census	Local News 7:00 am & Noon	4/29/20	3 minutes	Census deadlines have been extended in the summer and fall due to COVID-19.. Congressman Don Young encourages all Alaskans to fill out the census to ensure the right federal monies come to the state. Information given on where to go on the net to complete the census online.
<b>11</b>	COVID-19 – Flying	Local News 7:00 am & Noon	5/4/20	2 minutes	Alaska Airlines is now requiring face masks to be worn on all flights and in the airport. People are asked to provide their own mask. Also mentioned a few of the other safety measures Alaska Airlines is taking.
<b>12</b>	COVID-19 – Meat shortages	Local News 7:00 am & Noon	5/6/20	3 minutes	Meat shortages are in the lower 48 states, and Alaska stores are setting limits to prevent panic buying.
<b>13</b>	COVID-19 – Phase 2	Local News 7:00 am & Noon	5/7/20	3 minutes	Phase 2 for opening Alaska starts Friday. A list items changing was given.

<b>14</b>	COVID-19 – Travel	Local News 7:00 am & Noon	5/13/20	5 minutes	A new health mandate will allow travel within the state to communities connected by the road system or the Alaska Marine Highway. All travel outside the road system or the Marine Highway is still prohibited unless for critical personal needs or work for essential services. Also gave guidelines to listeners for while traveling.
<b>15</b>	Voting	Local News 6:00 pm & 10:00 PM	5/18/20	3 minutes	The State of Alaska will conduct the August primary election in the traditional manner. Voters have the options: absentee voting, early voting in person, or election day in person and can choose what is best for their situation while they are protecting themselves from COVID-19.
<b>16</b>	COVID-19 – State Reopening	Local News 6:00 pm & 10:00 PM	5/20/20	5 minutes	Gov. Mike Dunleavy announced that Alaska will be fully open for business, churches, and recreation at 100 percent capacity effective at 8 am Friday. Also gave some guidelines on how to keep people safe. Large gathering are still restricted.
<b>17</b>	Alaska Permanent Fund	Local News 7:00 am & Noon	5/21/20	2 minutes	The Alaska Permanent Fund Dividend will be sent out early this year on July 1 <sup>st</sup> to help people during the COVID-19 situation. People with applications that are still being processed may not receive payments until a later date. Payments will be made monthly until all eligible Alaskans have received it.
<b>18</b>	Cyber Security	Local News 6:00 pm & 10:00 PM	5/26/20	5 minutes	With employees working from home due to COVID-19 cyber security has become more important. Warnings were given that home networks do not always have the same security characteristics as a work environment. Warnings were also given about scams that are taking place to trick people into establishing a remote connection.
<b>19</b>	Job Searching	Local News 6:00 pm & 10:00 PM	6/1/20	7 minutes	A curated list of positions available throughout the state was given for those looking for work.
<b>20</b>	Alaska Tourism	Local News 7:00 am & Noon	6/3/20	3 minutes	A new website is offering deals for residents who book with local tourism businesses to encourage Alaskans to tour their own state. Gave website location and shared some of the things it offers.

<b>21</b>	Alaska Fires	Local News 6:00 pm & 10:00 PM	6/8/20	4 minutes	An update on the various fires in Alaska, and what to expect on the road systems near those fires.
<b>22</b>	Travel to Alaska	Local News 7:00 am & Noon	6/11/20	5 minutes	Alaska Health Mandate 10 says anyone traveling into the state must be tested no more than 72 hours before coming to Alaska, or be tested after they arrive and isolate until results come in, or quarantine for 14 days. Gave information about the lines to expect when arriving. Also gave some tips to make the process easier. A website was given for more information.
<b>23</b>	COVID-19	Local News 7:00 am & Noon	6/15/20	4 minutes	Update on how the state of Alaska is tracking COVID-19 cases to determine how the virus is spreading. Most industry workers are testing positive while they are in quarantine, and have had no exposure to others. Masks are a way to flatten the curve.
<b>24</b>	COVID-19 Travel through Canada	Local News 7:00 am & Noon	6/17/20	2 minutes	Restrictions on border crossings to Canada will stay in place for an extra month until July 21 <sup>st</sup> . Those traveling for essential work and trade are able to cross.
<b>25</b>	COVID-19 Alaska Marine Highway System	Local News 7:00 am & Noon	6/23/20	2 minutes	The Alaska Marine Highway System is implementing new operational protocols to protect against the transmission of COVID-19. A list of the new protocols was included.
<b>26</b>	Blood Donation	Local News 6:00 pm & 10:00 PM	6/23/20	2 minutes	The blood bank of Alaska is in critical need of donors who are O positive or negative. Contact information for the blood bank was given.
<b>27</b>	Housing Relief Program	Local News 6:00 pm & 10:00 PM	6/25/20	2 minutes	Friday is the last day to apply for the state's housing relief program. This is for Alaskans who have lost income because of COVID-19. Information about eligibility and applying was given.
<b>28</b>	COVID-19 – Airline Flying	Local News 6:00 pm & 10:00 PM	6/30/20	3 minutes	Alaska Airlines is cracking down on its masking policy by allowing flight attendants to issue final warnings. The guest's travel will be reviewed and could be suspended for a period.
