ONE OF THE PEOPLE ACCUSED OF MURDERING A WOMAN IN CHERRYFIELD AND LEAVING HER BODY ALONG THE SIDE OF A ROAD APPEARED BEFORE A JUDGE IN MACHIAS FRIDAY.

19-YEAR-OLD "QUANEYSHA GREELEY" OF NEW YORK WAS INDICTED ON MURDER CHARGES BY A WASHINGTON COUNTY GRAND JURY . SHE WAS IN COURT FRIDAY MORNING FOR HER ARRAIGNMENT. SHE'S BEING CHARGED WITH THE MURDER OF 55-YEAR-OLD "SALLY SHAW."

THE BODY OF SHAW WAS FOUND ALONG ON ROUTE 139 IN JULY AND HER RENTAL CAR WAS FOUND ABANDONED SEVERAL MILES AWAY. SHE HAD BEEN SHOT TO DEATH.

ACCORDING TO COURT DOCUMENTS, BOTH SHAW AND GREELEY HAD A ROMANTIC RELATIONSHIP WITH 37-YEAR-OLD CARINE REEVES WHO IS ALSO CHARGED IN SHAW'S MURDER.

ACCORDING TO COURT DOCUMENTS, KRAUSE CONFESSED TO THE
CRIMES WHEN POLICE ARRIVED ON THE SCENE.

THEY ALSO STATE KRAUSE TOLD A NURSE HE WAS A HEROIN USER,
ALTHOUGH THERE'S NO INDICATION HE HAD TAKEN THE DRUG PRIOR
TO THE MURDERS.

KRAUSE GREW UP IN THE ROCKPORT AREA AND WAS KNOWN AS A
GIFTED MUSICIAN.

THE CASE WILL NOW BE PRESENTED TO A GRAND JURY TO
CONSIDER WHETHER HE SHOULD BE INDICTED ON MURDER
CHARGES.

OFFICIALS SAY AGENTS WERE ABLE TO MAKE A NUMBER OF UNDERCOVER PURCHASES AT THE RESIDENCE AND DECIDED TO MOVE IN TUESDAY NIGHT.

THEY ENDED UP ARRESTING 49-YEAR-OLD "SHAWN LARTS" OF DORCHESTER, MASSACHUSETTS WHO HAS A LONG HISTORY OF GUN AND DRUG CRIMES.

THEY ALSO ARRESTED 64-YEAR-OLD "PAUL NESS" AND HIS 59-YEAR-OLD WIFE "YVONNE" FOR ALLOWING LARTS TO USE THEIR APARTMENT TO SELL DRUGS.

ALL THREE ARE CHARGED WITH AGGRAVATED TRAFFICKING IN SCHEDULED DRUGS.

OFFICIALS SAY THEY SEIZED 10 GRAMS OF CRACK COCAINE ... 25-HUNDRED DOLLARS IN CASH ALONG WITH OTHER DRUG EVIDENCE.
