To serve the public interest, the station broadcasts programming responsive to issues of concern to the CSRA and its listening public. The following lists issues most significant to our programming and the treatment of them:

Issues of importance this quarter included the following during the months of July, August, and September. In the month of July 2017, we welcomed several guests.
