To serve the public interest, the station broadcasts programming responsive to issues of concern to the CSRA and its listening public. The following lists issues most significant to our programming and the treatment of them:

Issues of importance this quarter included the following: In April, there was discussion about the incidence of rape and the partnership that the Rape Crisis Center has with several local hospitals in working with rape victims and opportunities for volunteers were mentioned as well. There was a discussion about the prevalence of asthma, especially in children, its causes and symptoms, and services GRU is providing in treating them. Community notes focused on the prevalence of the RSV that strikes many children, how to detect possible symptoms, and the need for treatment as well as the concerns that local citizens are having regarding the transfer of principals in the local school system. There was a broadcast that highlighted the findings of C. Suggs', which shows the impact that state legislative decisions are having on Georgia's educational system. Another broadcast highlighted tips from V. Showell, on pushing through when you don't feel like pushing any more and building a business. In May, information was shared regarding upcoming primary elections including candidates and primary/run-off dates for Georgia/the Augusta area, information regarding South Carolina's upcoming primary elections including candidates and polling dates was also highlighted. Lastly, GRU's MD/PhD program and the impact their Veggie Truck is having on a local neighborhood where the residents are able to buy fresh vegetables from GRU's Veggie Truck which is driven to the low-income neighborhood was discussed.
