To serve the public interest, the station broadcasts programming responsive to issues of concern to the CSRA and its listening public. The following lists issues most significant to our programming and the treatment of them:

**Issues** of importance this quarter included the following during the months of July, August, and September. In the month of July 2021, we welcomed several guests. At the Beginning of July, the note highlighted the United Way of the CSRA's "Stuff the Bus" program for students in need of school supplies, an Independence Day celebration event, and excerpts of the broadcast scheduled for July 5<sup>th</sup>. Dr. Coule appeared on the show to discuss diseases, including COVID – 19, how they invade the body and how they're treated. Ray Khalfani discussed the negative impact of prematurely cutting off unemployment insurance benefits. The note also included an update regarding a scheduled hearing on redistricting. Towards the middle of the month, the Community note highlighted findings of the ACSM and Anthem's findings of America's fittest cities and events in the local area. The note highlighted more events in the local area and an excerpt of Mr. Thornton's interview with Dr. Keel about the direction for Augusta University, leading in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century.
