Issues of importance this quarter included the following during the months of July. August, and September. In the month of July 2020, we welcomed several guests. Steve Luxenberg appeared on the show to discuss America's journey from slavery to segregation. The community note highlighted Perry Publishing and Broadcasting Company (PPBC) and Velvet Perry's honor as President-elect of the Georgia Association of Broadcaster's, exercise tips from the American College of Sports Medicine (ACSM), and Georgeia Budget and Poicy Institute (GBPI) push for revenue increases in the coming year.
