To serve the public interest, the station broadcasts programming responsive to issues of concern to the CSRA and its listening public. The following lists issues most significant to our programming and the treatment of them:

Issues of importance this quarter included the following during the months of October, November, and December. In the month of October 2022, we welcomed several guests. In the beginning of October 2022, Mr. Thornton aired highlights of his interview with the Praise 96.3FM sports announcer, Charles McNeil, and mentioned local events. Dr. Richard Averbeck appeared on the show to discuss The Law and the Christian. Mr. Thornton featured details regarding registering to vote and mentioned more local events. Brittany Walker and Jessica Quintero - Harris of Tri - Development Center of Aiken County, Inc. appeared on the show to talk about employment training and opportunities offered at their organization. Moving into the middle of the month, Dr. Janis Coffin of the Medical College of Georgia was interviewd to discuss breast cancer awareness.
