To serve the public interest, the station broadcasts programming responsive to issues of concern to the CSRA and its listening public. The following lists issues most significant to our programming and the treatment of them:

Issues of importance this quarter included the following during the months of October, November, and December. In the month of October 2018, we welcomed several guests. Zee Zee Wright, Jane Barrett, and John Beveridge of Augusta University visited the studio to talk about the Dream of Harlem play that helped raised money for the AU Cancer Research Center. Bruce Nagy appeared on the show to discuss clean energy. As we moved into the middle of October, Ms. Bratton of the Augusta African-American Historical Society appeared on the show to discuss the role of the society in informing the community about the legacy of its past and present black history-makers and their upcoming community history presentation. Dr. Stephen visited us to discuss practicing Christianity and Dr. Dale Atkins and Amanda Salzhauer visited us to discuss the advantage of being kind. Jose Humphrey joined the show to talk about ministering to the inner city population. Sharkie Zartman appeared on the show to discuss how parents can develop successful young athletes.
