To serve the public interest, the station broadcasts programming responsive to issues of concern to the CSRA and its listening public. The following lists issues most significant to our programming and the treatment of them:

Issues of importance this quarter included the following: During the month of July, Carl discussed the importance of getting students vaccinated before school starts, measures parents can take when abused by their children and precautions to take during hot summer months, several first aid measures to take in case of heart illnesses and ways parents can respond when being abused by their children, an educational partnership between United Ways of Georgia and Great Promise Partnership, Inc. and the All-Star Charity award given to United Way Worldwide. Summer activities were also promoted. Dr. Valorie Parker discussed the importance of caring for the soul and a retreat that will deal with the whole person.
