TYPHOON BOLAVEN:

Guam was placed in Condition of Readiness (COR) 2 as of Sunday, October 8, 2023, at 8:00 PM. PBS Guam (KGTF) closed its doors in preparation for Tropical Storm Bolaven. Broadcast operations stopped on Sunday, October 8, 2023, at 9:00 PM.

Bolaven was upgraded from a tropical storm to a category 1 typhoon on Tuesday, October 10, 2023. Typhoon Bolaven passed Guam without major damage.

Guam returns to Condition of Readiness (COR) 4 on Wednesday, October 11, 2023, at 10:00 AM. PBS Guam (KGTF) went back to normal broadcast hours on Wednesday, October 11, 2023, at 6:00 AM.
