A replacement facility was set up in a nearby neighborhood, although much smaller.

We told viewers how the decision was overturned in 2022, and the slew of new state bans on abortion since. We spoke with Washington's Junior Senator about her work to recruit to Washington State providers who no longer feel comfortable practicing in their home states.

The spill happened along State Route 534, a highway that will be closed for several hours while crews install a crane for the cleanup. We also reminded viewers about two upcoming public meetings about the spill.

The chief is facing mounting pressure to fire the cop or to suspend him without pay. Department commanders told us that the fallout from the video harmed the department's reputation on a "global" scale after the footage went viral on social media.

Business owners complain the bill doesn't go far enough, especially when the crime involves a juvenile.
