It houses up to 14 families for an average of 6 months each. The children are able to get daily counseling on-site as well as attend school at the shelter, and the moms have legal advocacy as well as counseling and educational opportunities as well. The shelter takes the families on field trips to parks and museums and provides therapeutic care to help them break the generational cycle of violence. The shelter is secretly located and extremely secure and their goal is to see women become emotionally and financially independent.
