Fruit Broadcasting, LLC General Manager Ron Fruit and Office Manager Beth Fruit represented WRCO AM/FM Radio at two job fairs hosted by the Wisconsin Broadcasters Association. The first was held in January 22, 2014 in Madison, Wisconsin and the other June 18, 2014 in Sheboygan, Wisconsin. WRCO broadcast:60 promotional announcements advertising the fairs.

Fruit Broadcasting, LLC General Manager Ron Fruit and Office Manager Beth Fruit represented WRCO AM/FM Radio in the continuing education workshops sponsored by the Wisconsin Broadcasters Association on hiring and employment rules. At the annual WBA winter convention January 22, 2014, the Fruits attended "Hiring Smart for Broadcasters: Legal Issues in Hiring and Effective Strategies to promote Equal Employment Opportunity and Prevent Unlawful Discrimination."
