Following our stories, some state agencies changed their policies; deciding to hold off on arresting people based solely on the results of a field test. Now, word of our investigation has spread and is prompting change with law enforcement agencies worldwide.

Officials have issued mandatory evacuation orders for 120-thousand people in the Florida panhandle ahead of the hurricane. And some of them are headed here to metro Atlanta. Fox 5's Doug Evans has more from the Atlanta motor speedway in henry county where evacuees are invited to camp.

Out of Cuba and on to the united states. Hurricane Michael is making a path towards the panhandle. Right now mandatory evacuations are underway in Panama City beach and other low lying parts of the Florida coast.

Hurricane Michael is the strongest storm to hit mainland US in decades---making landfall along Florida Panhandle where many metro Atlantans own homes or vacation---then zooming into southwest Georgia (still as a hurricane) leaving widespread damage. The storm flattens cities along the coast like Mexico Beach and Port St. Joe in Florida--and left nearly a half-billion dollars in agriculture and infrastructure damage in Georgia.

Right now, the Georgia emergency management agency is at "full scale activation" as it monitors the movements of this monster storm. The governor has declared a state of emergency for 108 counties. That means state agencies are prepared to respond to whatever destruction hurricane Michael dishes out.

United States Marines – TOYS FOR TOTS

The U.S. Marines annual toy collection program is the largest in Georgia that provides new toys for needy and homeless children. The campaign is a strongly supported effort by FOX 5 Helping Hands, Publix Super Markets, United Way, FedEx, Pepsico, All News 106.7 and Q100.

FOX 5 produced and aired an extensive PSA schedule, provided live remotes which included entertainment scheduled by the news planning department at various locations, and provided interview opportunities on Good Day Atlanta.

The 2018 goal was to collect approximately 850,000 toys.
