The most significant community issues during this period covered by Nevada Public Radio are listed here. The producers and Program Director direct the content and selection of the program KNPR's State of Nevada airing weekdays 9 – 10am and 7 – 8pm.

April 5, 2022 - *Retirees, younger residents flood Reno housing market, push prices to record high*

- What does the future hold for Reno as younger people move in, housing costs increase and Renoites move out?

June 1, 2022 - *In years since 1 October, can Nevada lawmakers do anything to stop mass shootings in the US?*

- More than a dozen mass shootings occurred in the U.S. this Memorial Day weekend. Is there a way to keep it from happening again?

June 7, 2022 - *Leaders want to make schools safer after Uvalde shooting, but what does that look like in CCSD?*

- After it happened in many other schools over the years, the Texas school shooting seems like it might be a wake up call.

June 8, 2022 - *More people experiencing homelessness are living in cars around Las Vegas*

- Short term rentals are the bane of some neighbors, and the lifeblood to some families. They are also a huge corporate business now, and they're coming back to unincorporated Clark County.

June 23, 2022 - *'This is who I am. This is what I do': LGBTQ cops in Southern Nevada share adversity of representing both*
