Our ancestors ate...Jesus maybe is grinning at this point as he is about to unveil the biggest mystery of all time...</p>
						<p>(cont'd) FATHER MILLER Then we go complex to simple: The story of Naaham from 2 Kings 5:10-14 RSV-CE 10 And Elisha sent a messenger to him, saying, "Go and wash in the Jordan seven times, and your flesh shall be restored, and you shall be clean." 11 But Naaman was angry, and went away, saying, "Behold, I thought that he would surely come out to me, and stand, and call on the name of the LORD his God, and wave his hand over the place, and cure the leper. 12 Are not Abana and Pharpar, the rivers of Damascus, better than all the waters of Israel? Could I not wash in them, and be clean?" So he turned and went away in a rage. 13 But his servants came near and said to him, "My father, if the prophet had commanded you to do some great thing, would you not have done it?
