Section I. Issues

The stations have identified the following as significant issues facing our community in this quarter.

- A. Idaho athletes profiting from Name, Image, and Likeness.** Several states along with the NCAA will now allow college athletes to earn money while playing sports for their school. We interview a sports expert on how this will impact the games in Idaho across the country.
- B. Idaho's Earliest Gubernatorial Race has already started.** Several candidates on the Republican Party have declared their candidacy for governor. The incumbent, Republican Governor Brad Little has yet to declare for reelection but is expected to soon. We speak with a veteran campaign operative on Gem State Politics.
- C. Vaccination or Termination.** Idaho's three largest healthcare providers declared that all personnel must be vaccinated or they will be fired. We speak with a group of nurses and a state senator fighting to keep their freedom of choice.
- D. Central District Health's New Direction.** Doctor Ryan Cole shares his views on alternatives to the vaccine. He was appointed to the board of the state's largest health district. His nomination caused some folks to question why he was appointed. He discusses his views on several Covid issues.
- E. President Biden Visits Idaho Preview.** Idaho Republican State Chairman Tom Luna previews the president's trip to Idaho.
- F. President Biden Visits Idaho Reaction.** Congressman Russ Fulcher reviews the president's comments while in Idaho including the addition of hundreds of Afghan Refugees to the Gem State.

Section II. Responsive Programs

Idaho Insights is a **30-minute** public affairs program written and produced by Townsquare Media in Boise, Idaho. The topics addressed are drawn from issues in the city of Boise and the surrounding communities. The program airs on all six Townsquare Media stations in Boise, Idaho **every Sunday** as follows: **KXLT-FM, KAWO-FM, KIDO-AM** and **KFXD-AM** at **6:00 a.m.** and **KSAS-FM** and **KCIX-FM** at **7:00 a.m.**

7/4/21: Idaho athletes profiting from Name, Image, and Likeness. Sports reporter Terry Ford provides a history of the relationship between college athletes and the NCAA. Thanks to a recent supreme court ruling and several states empowering athletes to be paid, now every college athlete has the chance to profit off of their name, image, and likeness. Ford describes how this will impact Boise State Football players who have large social media followings. He further looks at how NIL will impact the recruitment of athletes.

7/11/21: Idaho's Earliest Gubernatorial Race has already started. Phil Hardy a political operative explains why high profile candidates such as Ammon Bundy, Lt. Gov. Janice McGeachin, and Ed Humphreys have begun raising money and campaigning to replace Idaho's Republican Governor Brad

Little. Hardy reports on the state of the state's Republican Party which has a super majority in both state houses. The governor has yet to declare for reelection but is expected to before the end of the year. Hardy explains how national Democrats have begun to target Idaho in hopes of turning the 'reddest of the red' to purple or blue.

7/18/21: Greater Idaho. Several Oregon counties have begun the move to secede from Oregon in hopes of becoming part of Idaho. Their movement is called Greater Idaho and their President Mike McCarter joins us to discuss how his group intends to leave Oregon. He has successfully met with members of the Idaho Legislature and had several Oregon counties vote to leave that state. McCarter is serious about his movement planning to become part of Idaho legally.

7/25/21: Idaho's Vaccination or Termination part 1. Victoria Stump, founder, Take A Stand Now, details why Idaho's largest health care providers, Saint Luke's Saint Alphonsus, and Primary Health have dictated that employees must be vaccinated or will be terminated. She has and continues to organize rallies and protests around area hospitals. Idaho is already suffering from a worker shortage in healthcare. The Covid crisis has only worsened the situation. The group plans to begin a billboard campaign in hopes of preserving healthcare jobs

8/1/21: Idaho's Vaccination or Termination part 2. State Senator Christy Zito explains why the Idaho Legislature did not pass legislation protecting Idaho workers during the session. The senator reveals that she and the lieutenant governor have asked the speaker of the house to reconvene the legislature. Senator Zito and a group of senators have met with Take A Stand Now and say they want to meet with the hospitals and the workers in hopes of a solution outside of government.

8/8/21: Idaho's Young Republicans Outreach. Daniel Silver, the president of the Idaho Young Republicans, reports on how the state's young people react to politics. Mr. Silver through his grassroots efforts has recruited hundreds of new Republicans. He discusses how important getting out to vote is regardless of your political party. He reveals a new community service initiative that is nonpartisan involving volunteering for nonprofit organizations.

8/15/21: Idaho Company Banned by Facebook Butch Whiting Founder/President of Kryptek Industries reports on how the insurrection in Washington DC got his company banned from Facebook. Mr. Whiting says that some of the folks at the capitol were wearing his gear and that was enough for Facebook to boot them off their platform. The company has agreements with several Hollywood movie studios and video game makers. Mr. Whiting details the amount of revenue his company lost due to the Facebook decision. He believes Congress should look at regulating social media platforms. Idaho Legislature

8/22/21: Central District Health's News Direction part 1. Doctor Ryan Cole is a Mayo Clinic trained doctor who has called the vaccine needle rape. He has been very critical of mask and vaccine mandates. Doctor Cole is now a finalist for the health board that regulates Ada, Boise, Elmore, and Valley Counties. Doctor Cole explains that the virus continues to change advocating a personal choice on whether or not one should take the vaccine

8/29/21: Central District Health's New Direction part 2. Doctor Cole answers questions from listeners during a town hall format. The topics included side effects from the vaccine, natural immunity, the role of government in public health, and the use of ivermectin in treating Covid symptoms.

9/5/21: Idaho's Youth Movement in Politics. Republican Gubernatorial Candidate Ed Humphreys explains life of the trail. The thirty something candidate is the youngest candidate in the growing field of Republicans seeking to become Idaho's next governor. He reports on how the age differences in voters impacts what issues are most important to them. Mr. Humphreys says that entitlements are more important to older Idahoan than to those new to the workforce. He explains why he left his career of managing over \$40 million in assets run for governor.

9/12/21: President Biden Comes to Idaho Preview. The president announced that he will visit the Interagency Fire Center in Boise, Idaho. This is Biden's first trip to Idaho as the president. Tom Luna, the chairman of the Idaho Republican Party Power. The president's stay will be a short one discussing forest fires and global warming. Chairman Luna says that this is another sign that the Democrats want to take over Idaho. He compares their efforts here to Colorado flipping from Red to Blue. Chairman Luna reports that a presidential visit is a big boost to Idaho Democrats.

9/19/21: President Biden Leaves Idaho. Reaction Idaho Congressman Russ Fulcher criticized the president's short appearance in Idaho. The president did meet briefly with Governor Little. After Air Force One took off, Biden announced that Boise and Twin Falls would be getting hundreds of Afghan refugees. Congressman Fulcher revealed that the state is very concerned over the lack of vetting of these individuals to Idaho.

9/26/21: Idaho's Fentanyl Crisis Gains National Attention. Canyon County Sheriff Kieran Donahue explains why Fox News sent a reporter to his county for a story that appeared on Fox and Friends. Donahue told Fox that 96% of Idaho's drugs are coming from Mexico. He reported on two of his deputies that were hospitalized due to exposure to the deadly drug Fentanyl.
