An African-American woman suspected of having mental problems in New York City, has repeatedly attacked passers-by in the city since last year, mostly Asians. She was arrested by the police last Thursday (22nd) and charged with hatred, serious harassment, assault, robbery and illegal possession of weapons. From May to last Wednesday (21st), 25-year-old Maricia Bell attacked 4 Asians, including spitting at a 63-year-old Asian woman and attacking a 73-year-old from behind with a hammer. According to reports, Bell has repeatedly assaulted passers-by since last year, but was fined lightly for suspected mental problems. The New York City police appealed to people to report to the police for help if they are attacked, regardless of whether they have legal immigration status or not.
