Thomas has been with the district since 1997 when she was named Director of Human resources and Employee Benefits. In 2003, she moved into the role of Assistant Superintendent for Human Resources, Public Relations and Community Involvement, and was later named the Deputy Superintendent in 2008.

Since that time, she has overseen Human Resources, elementary campuses, instructional services, special education and federal program, information technology, instruction technology, health services, textbook distribution and business operations.

Thomas, who has elected not to pursue the position of superintendent, will move into the acting superintendent role on Wednesday.
