On July 2-3 the Miller County Sheriff's Office, after consultation with the Arkansas Department of Health, conducted faculty-wide testing for COVID-19.

All persons incarcerated, along with all employees at the Sheriff's Complex, received tests provided by the Arkansas Department of Health. Over the weekend, ADH tested all submitted samples.

On Monday, the Miller County Sheriff's Office received a report from the ADH reflecting that 85 of the approximately 335 tests administered tested positive for the COVID-19.

Of those testing positive, all are currently asymptomatic. A total of five employees tested positive, and are included in the total number, and they are likewise, asymptomatic.

All persons who develop symptoms will receive additional screening and will receive immediate medical intervention. The Arkansas Department of Health, the Miller County Detention Center Medical Director, and the Miller County Detention Center Medical Staff work diligently to implement recommended protocols.
