The number of confirmed coronavirus cases in Miller County, Arkansas, increased by 10 from Monday to Tuesday, reaching 612.

The Arkansas Department of Health reported 566 recoveries in the county, with nine deaths and 37 active cases.

Lafayette County's case count rose from 68 to 70, Pike County's from 176 to 177, Little River County's from 281 to 284 and Sevier County's from 1,157 to 1,159.

Nevada County's count held at 162, Hempstead County's at 330 and Howard County's at 425.

In Northeast Texas, Morris County's case count went up from 156 to 158 and Titus County's from 1,356 to 1,360, according to the Texas Department of State Health Services. Red River County's count held at 145.

The local emergency Joint Operations Center did not release statistics Tuesday for Bowie and Cass counties in Texas.

Caddo Parish in Northwest Louisiana added 35 cases to reach 7,452, and Bossier Parish added 25 cases to reach 2,728, according to the Louisiana Department of Health.

Statewide, Arkansas reported 61,497 cumulative cases with 814 deaths, Louisiana reported 148,882 cases and 4,821 deaths, and Texas reported 617,333 cases and 12,681 deaths.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported 6,004,443 total cases so far in the U.S., with a national death toll of 183,050.
