The number of confirmed coronavirus cases in Miller County, Arkansas, rose by three from Tuesday to Wednesday, reaching a total of 673.

The Arkansas Department of Health also reported 601recoveries in thecounty, 10 deaths and 62 active cases.

Elsewhere in Southwest Arkansas, Lafayette County's case count rose from 76 to 77, Pike County's from 189 to 191, Nevada County's from 166 to 170, Little River County's from 307 to 311 and Sevier County's from 1,173 to 1,174, according to ADH. Hempstead County's tally held at 337 cases and Howard County's at 437.

In Northeast Texas, Bowie County reported 1,046 cases, up from 1,040, with 641 recoveries, 71 deaths and 334 active cases, according to the local emergency Joint Operations Center.

Cass County's tally held at 267, with 236 recoveries, 12 deaths and 19 active cases, according to the JOC.

Red River County's count increased from 151 to 152, Morris County's from 162 to 164 and Titus County's from 1,387 to 1,392, according to the Texas Department of State Health Services.

Caddo Parish in Northwest Louisiana added 42 cases to reach 7,729, and Bossier Parish added 13 to reach 2,849, according to the Louisiana Department of Health.

Statewide, Arkansas reported 66,406 cumulative cases and 928 deaths, Louisiana reported 154,955 cases and 4,970 deaths, and Texas reported 645,791 cases and 13,692 deaths.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported 6,310,663 total cases so far in the U.S., with a national death toll of 189,147.
