The deadline to file individual state income taxes is midnight this Wednesday. In March, the federal government extended the individual tax filing deadline from mid-April to July 15 in response to the coronavirus pandemic. Scott Hardin, spokesperson for the Arkansas's Department of Finance and Administration, says the state expected more people to file closer to the revised deadline.

The state adjusted its forecasted budget by \$353 million dollars, in anticipation of delayed individual income tax payments, but Hardin says most of that amount has already been collected.

Arkansans have until midnight Wednesday to file their individual state income taxes. The state follows federal tax deadlines, which were extended from April 15 to July 15 earlier this year due to the pandemic. Arkansas's Department of Finance and Administration spokesman Scott Hardin says more in the state are opting to file on-line this year.
