Bowie County, Texas' number of confirmed coronavirus cases increased by 13, from 848 to 861, Wednesday to Thursday, according to the local emergency Joint Operations Center.

Four-hundred ten Bowie County COVID-19 patients have recovered, 56 have died, and 395 active cases are being traced in the county.

Cass County, Texas' count rose from 206 to 213, with 166 recoveries, nine deaths and 38 active cases, according to the JOC.

Elsewhere in Northeast Texas, Morris County's tally went up from 135 to 137 and Titus County's from 1,276 to 1,285, according to the Texas Department of State Health Services. Red River County's case count held at 140.

In Southwest Arkansas, Miller County's case count held at 541, with 507 recoveries, five deaths and 29 active cases, according to the Arkansas Department of Health.

Lafayette County's count increased from 63 to 64, Nevada County's from 147 to 150, Little River County's from 237 to 248, Hempstead County's from 277 to 284, Howard County's from 380 to 383 and Sevier County's from 1,079 to 1,086. Pike County's count held at 151.

Caddo Parish in Northwest Louisiana added 48 cases for a total of 7,060, and Bossier Parish added nine cases to reach 2,508, according to the Louisiana Department of Health.

Statewide, Texas reported 562,559 cumulative cases and 10,793 deaths, Louisiana reported 140,821 cases with 4,496 deaths, and Arkansas reported 54,765 cases with 641 deaths.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported 5,506,929 total cases so far in the U.S., with a national death toll of 172,416.
