From Wednesday to Thursday, Bowie County, Texas, reported 13 new confirmed coronavirus cases and Miller County, Arkansas, reported eight.

Bowie County's case count rose from 783 to 796, with 324 recoveries, 51 deaths and 421 active cases being traced, according to the local emergency Joint Operations Center.

Cass County, Texas' case count held at 185, with 137 recoveries, eight deaths and 40 active cases, according to the JOC.

Elsewhere in Northeast Texas, Morris County's tally increased from 127 to 130, Red River County's from 137 to 140 and Titus County's from 1,231 to 1,250, according to the Texas Department of State Health Services.

In Southwest Arkansas, Miller County's count rose from 519 to 527, with 480 recoveries, five deaths and 42 active cases, according to the Arkansas Department of Health.

Pike County's count went up from 118 to 126, Nevada County's from 146 to 147, Little River County's from 189 to 193, Hempstead County's from 253 to 255, Howard County's from 360 to 362 and Sevier County's from 1,009 to 1,017. Lafayette County held at 58 cases.

Caddo Parish in Northwest Louisiana added 80 cases for a total of 6,851, and Bossier Parish added 38 cases to reach 2,428, according to the Louisiana Department of Health.

Statewide, Arkansas reported 50,411 cumulative cases and 566 deaths, Louisiana reported 135,439 cases with 4,279 deaths, and Texas reported 513,575 cases with 9,289.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported 5,176,018 total cases so far in the U.S., with a national death toll of 165,148.
