

The COVID-19 death toll among Bowie County, Texas, residents reached 28 on Monday, up from 26 on Friday, according to the local emergency Joint Operations Center.

The county's cumulative case count increased by almost 40 over the weekend, from 353 to 391. One-hundred eighty-six Bowie County patients have recovered, and there are 177 active cases in the county.

Cass County, Texas' tally rose from 57 to 62, with 35 recoveries and two deaths, leaving 25 active cases, according to the JOC.

Elsewhere in Northeast Texas, Red River County's case count increased from 119 to 123 and Titus County's from 851 to 887, while Morris County's held at 51 cases, according to the Texas Department of State Health Services.

Eight counties in Southwest Arkansas reported more cases, according to the Arkansas Department of Health.

Miller County's count rose by 43, from 237 to 280. One-hundred thirty-two Miller County patients have recovered from COVID-19, and two have died. There are 146 active cases in the county.

Pike County's tally increased from 19 to 20, Lafayette County's from 24 to 30, Little River County's from 40 to 45, Hempstead County's from 70 to 87, Nevada County's from 107 to 110, Howard County's from 121 to 138 and Sevier County's from 781 to 811.

Caddo Parish in Northwest Louisiana added 200 cases from Friday to Monday, for a total of 4,413, and Bossier Parish added 38 cases to reach 1,315, according to the Louisiana Department of Health.

Statewide, Arkansas reported 28,939 cumulative cases with 323 deaths, Louisiana reported 79,827 cases with 3,315 deaths, and Texas reported 264,313 cases with 3,235 deaths.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported 3,296,599 total cases so far in the U.S., with a national death toll of 134,884.
