TEXARKANA, Texas — Texarkana's Cinemark movie theater will reopen in a week with the Russell Crowe thriller "Unhinged" on tap as the movie choice.

Cinemark had previously intended to reopen the local cinema in early July but scrapped those plans as the company rescheduled a phased reopening.
