From Tuesday to Thursday, the number of confirmed coronavirus cases in Miller County, Arkansas, increased from 705 to 730, and Bowie County, Texas' case count rose from 1,118 to 1,139.

The Bowie County Emergency Operations Center reported 667 recoveries, 71 deaths and 401 active cases.

Miller County reported 665 recoveries, 10 deaths and 55 active cases, according to the Arkansas Department of Health.

Cass County, Texas, reported an increase of cases from 291 to 303, with 257 recoveries, 14 deaths and 32 active cases, according to the EOC.

Elsewhere in Northeast Texas, Morris County's tally rose from 174 to 175, Titus County's from 1,415 to 1,420 and Red River County's from 157 to 158, according to the Texas Department of State Health Services.

In Southwest Arkansas, Lafayette County's case count increased from 80 to 85, Nevada County's from 184 to 186, Little River County's from 321 to 325, and Hempstead County's from 340 to 344, according to ADH. Pike County's count held at 213, Howard County'sat 447 cases and Sevier County's at 1,183.

Caddo Parish in Northwest Louisiana added 140 cases to reach 8,069, and Bossier Parish added 52 to reach 3,005, according to the Louisiana Department of Health.

Statewide, Arkansas reported 71,614 cumulative cases and 1,166 deaths, Louisiana reported 159,304 cases and 5,143 deaths, and Texas reported 678,819 cases and 14,590 deaths.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported 6,613,331 total cases so far in the U.S., with a national death toll of 196,277.
