The Liberty-Eylau Independent School District announced Monday morning that a high school student tested positive for COVID-19 and was last on campus Aug. 24.

According to a letter sent out by Superintendent Ronnie Thompson, the district was notified of the positive case Sunday, Aug. 30.

The letter states:

"In keeping with Liberty-Eylau ISD's practices to respond to COVID-19, we are notifying all LEISD families that the district was notified on August 30 of a high school student who was lab-confirmed to have COVID-19. The last time the student was on campus was August 24. Due to privacy requirements, we will not be releasing the name of the individual or details that may identify him or her.

The district has completed contact tracing and we have contacted individuals determined to be in close contact with the infected individual. Any students or staff that came into close contact have been directly notified. If you were not directly notified, your child was not in contact with the infected person. We will keep you apprised of further updates.

As a health and safety reminder everyone should watch for symptoms of COVID-19.
