

TEXARKANA, Texas — The school district reported Tuesday that a Texas High School student had tested positive for COVID-19.

Texarkana Independent School District sent notifications out to parents/guardians and staff members that same day.

According to Chief Communications Officer Tina Veal-Gooch, the student was last on campus Monday, and no additional students needed to be quarantined.

According to the notification letter sent out to parents and staff, anyone who school officials determined to be in close contact with the student were also notified.

"While we do not have reason to believe those who were not in close contact with the infected individual have reason to be concerned, we ask that you as always, watch for symptoms of COVID-19," the letter states.
