Bowie County, Texas, reported four deaths because of COVID-19 on Wednesday, bringing the county's total to 51.

The county's number of confirmed coronavirus cases increased from 779 to 783 Tuesday to Wednesday, with 323 recoveries and 409 active cases being traced, according to the local joint Emergency Operations Center.

Cass County, Texas' case count rose from 779 to 783, with 128 recoveries, eight deaths and 49 active cases, according to the EOC.

Elsewhere in Northeast Texas, Morris County's tally increased from 125 to 127 and Titus County's from 1,212 to 1,226, according to the Texas Department of State Health Services. Red River County's case count held at 137.

Caddo Parish in Northwest Louisiana added 32 cases for a total of 6,771, and Bossier Parish added 16 cases to reach 2,390, according to the Louisiana Department of Health.

Statewide, Texas reported 506,820 cumulative cases and 9,034 deaths, and Louisiana reported 134,304 cases with 4,238 deaths.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported 5,119,711 total cases so far in the U.S., with a national death toll of 163,651.
