

TEXARKANA, Texas — The State Executive Committee of the [University Interscholastic League](#) will convene at 9:30 a.m. Wednesday to determine the eligibility of student-athletes, including an appeal regarding Pleasant Grove.

The District 8-4A, Division II committee's decision of Pleasant Grove will regard a student-athlete allegedly "Changing Schools for Athletic Purposes," according to a UIL press release. The release, however, did not name the student.

Other items on the agenda include appeal hearings for College Station A&M Consolidated High School and Poteet High School.

The meeting is open, and all interested parties are welcome to view the live stream on the [UIL State Executive Committee page](#). There is no physical location for this meeting in order to ensure safe social distancing, the press release stated.

On Tuesday, the UIL announced a student-athlete from Burnet High School and two student-athletes from Converse Judson High School were denied an appeal for varsity eligibility, upholding the previous ruling of the district executive committees.
