

Bowie County, Texas, added six to its number of confirmed coronavirus cases Wednesday, while Miller County, Arkansas' count remained the same.

Bowie County reported 848 cumulative cases, with 402 recoveries, 56 deaths and 390 active cases, according to the local emergency Joint Operations Center.

Cass County, Texas, added three cases to reach 206, with 161 recoveries, nine deaths and 36 active cases, according to the JOC.

Elsewhere in Northeast Texas, Titus County's tally rose from 1,273 to 1,276, according to the Texas Department of State Health Services.

Morris County's count held at 135 cases and Red River County's at 140.

In Southwest Arkansas, Miller County's case count held at 541, with 503 recoveries, five deaths and 33 active cases, according to the Arkansas Department of Health.

Lafayette County's count increased from 62 to 63, Pike County's from 146 to 151, Little River County's from 227 to 237, Hempstead County's from 272 to 277, Howard County's from 376 to 380 and Sevier County's from 1,074 to 1,079. Nevada County held at 147.

Caddo Parish in Northwest Louisiana added 32 cases for a total of 7,012, and Bossier Parish added 11 cases to reach 2,499, according to the Louisiana Department of Health.

Statewide, Texas reported 557,256 cumulative cases and 10,559 deaths, Louisiana reported 139,903 cases with 4,468 deaths, and Arkansas reported 54,216 cases with 631 deaths.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported 5,460,429 total cases so far in the U.S., with a national death toll of 171,012.
