Bowie County, Texas, on Tuesday reported seven fatalities because of COVID-19 since Monday, bringing the county's death toll to 47.

The number of confirmed coronavirus cases in the county rose by 10, from 769 to 779, with 323 recoveries and 409 active cases being traced, according to the local emergency Joint Operations Center.

Cass County, Texas' count held at 176, with 99 recoveries, eight deaths and 69 active cases, according to the JOC.

Elsewhere in Northeast Texas, Morris County's tally increased from 117 to 125, Red River County's from 136 to 137 and Titus County's from 1,212 to 1,226, according to the Texas Department of State Health Services.

In Southwest Arkansas, Miller County's case count held at 118, with 458 recoveries, five deaths and 55 active cases, according to the Arkansas Department of Health.

Lafayette County's count rose from 54 to 56, Pike County's from 108 to 111, Little River County's from 181 to 185, Hempstead County's from 247 to 249, Howard County's from 342 to 355 and Sevier County's from 992 to 996. Nevada County's count held at 143.

Caddo Parish in Northwest Louisiana added 51 cases for a total of 6,739, and Bossier Parish added 35 cases to reach 2,374, according to the Louisiana Department of Health.

Statewide, Texas reported 500,620 cumulative cases — topping the half-million mark for the first time — and 8,913 deaths.

Arkansas reported 50,411 cases with 566 deaths, and Louisiana reported 133,125 cases with 4,195 deaths.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported 5,064,171 total cases so far in the U.S., with a national death toll of 162,407.
