

Officials reported another death because of COVID-19 over the weekend in Bowie County, Texas, bringing the county's total to 40.

Since Friday, the county's cumulative number of confirmed coronavirus counties jumped by more than 50, from 713 to 769, the local emergency Joint Operations Center reported Monday. There are 421 active cases being traced in the county, and 308 Bowie County patients have recovered.

Cass County, Texas' case count increased by 10, from 166 to 176, with 99 recoveries, eight deaths and 69 active cases, according to the JOC.

COVID-19 deaths are recorded where patients die, not where they lived.

Elsewhere in Northeast Texas, Morris County's tally rose from 105 to 117 and Titus County's from 1,196 to 1,212, according to the Texas Department of State Health Services. Officials adjusted Red River County's case count downward, from 137 to 136.

In Southwest Arkansas, Miller County added 19 cases to reach 518, with 449 recoveries, five deaths and 64 active cases, according to the Arkansas Department of Health.

Lafayette County's count rose from 52 to 54, Pike County's from 97 to 108, Nevada County's from 137 to 143, Little River County's from 168 to 181, Hempstead County's from 233 to 247, Howard County's from 327 to 342 and Sevier County's from 976 to 992.

Caddo Parish in Northwest Louisiana added 78 cases for a total of 6,688, and Bossier Parish added 28 cases to reach 2,339, according to the Louisiana Department of Health.

Statewide, Arkansas reported 50,028 cases with 555 deaths. Louisiana reported 131,961 cases with 4,169 deaths, and Texas reported 490,817 cases with 8,490 deaths.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported 5,023,649 total cases so far in the U.S., with a national death toll of 161,842.
